


DR. DRILL 'N FILL™

Today, the patient is visiting the dentist.



**Pretend to be a dentist! Try saying:
“Open your mouth, Mr. Patient.
I am going to brush your teeth so they are clean.”**



First, get the toothbrush ready to brush your patient's teeth.



First, you roll a red PLAY-DOH ball.



Next, you place the red ball on the back of the toothbrush.



Push the PLAY-DOH ball so it is flat.



When you turn the toothbrush over, the toothpaste is on the brush.

Now you are ready to brush your patient's teeth.



Start with the bottom teeth and pretend to brush the outside.



Next, you brush the inside of the bottom teeth.




When the bottom teeth are done, you can brush the top teeth. Start with the outside.



Finally, you brush the inside of the top teeth.

Next, you can count your patient's teeth.

**Uh oh, you found a cavity.
This is OK. You can fill the cavity.**



It is time for you to make a silver PLAY-DOH filling.



First, make a small silver PLAY-DOH ball. This will be the filling.



Then, put the small silver ball in the hole in the tooth to fill the cavity.



Next, lightly push the filling into the cavity.



You are all done filling in the cavity. Your patient's tooth is OK.

**Your patient is happy that his cavity is filled.
Your patient's appointment is all done.**



**As the dentist, you can tell the patient:
“Brush your teeth two times a day to keep them healthy.”**
