

That mischievous pup! He sneaked into the bathroom, hopped into the tub, and now he's taking a bubble bath! The bubbles are flying, and it's up to you to race to the tub and grab his towel so he'll stop all that bubblin'. To get to the FINISH, you'll catch bubbles, pop bubbles, and even blow some bubbles yourself!

### **OBJECT**

To be the first player to reach the bathtub FINISH and turn over the pup's towel.

# **EQUIPMENT**

- BUBBLE UP PUP™ in the bathtub and labels
   Vinvl mat
- Bubble bucket and label 4 Movers with bubble wands
- Bottle of bubble solution
   4 Plastic towels
   Spinner
- 1 D-Size battery required (not included)

# **ASSEMBLY**

- Apply labels to bubble bucket and each side of the tub.
- To assemble tub, see back of this sheet.

### **SETUP**

- 1. Place the assembled tub in the center of the vinyl game board. Be sure you're playing on a level surface.
- 2. Mix up the 4 red plastic "towels" and place them face down in the towel basket at the end of the track, just past FINISH.
- 3. Each player picks a mover and places it on START.
- 4. Press the faucet knob (behind the pup) to start the bubble wheel. This gets the bubble wheel wet. Note: The "faucet" will shut itself off automatically.

### **GAME PLAY**

The youngest player goes first. Play passes to the left.

# On your turn:

- Push the pup's head DOWN. (Push it at the start of each turn.)
- Spin the spinner and do what the spinner indicates.
- Note: Players may occupy the same space on the track.



# What did you spin?

Number: If you spin a 4, 6, or 8, press down the tub faucet knob and, when the bubbles come up, try to catch that many (4, 6, or 8) bubbles in the bubble bucket. Everybody may help you count out loud as you catch them,



"One, two, three, four...." Try to catch the full number, but even if you don't, move your mover the number of spaces equal to the number of bubbles you caught—but NOT MORE than the number you spun!

**Pop Pop!:** Press the faucet knob to start the bubbles. ALL players POP the bubbles with their fingers, or CLAP them between their hands, then ALL players move to the next yellow bubble space. • **Note:** If a player is already on the last POP POP! space, he or she does not move forward.



**Go To Front**: Pick up your mover, dip it into the front bubble solution reservoir, and blow as many bubbles as you can! Now move your mover to the space at the front of the line! (If you were already the leader, move forward one space.)



**Soap:** Oooooppppps! Land on the soap space, and you must slide all the way back to the space in back of the mover who's last in line. (If you're already last, move back one space.)



#### WINNING

Play continues until one player has reached the bathtub FINISH space. That player turns over **one** of the 4 towels. If it's the pup's own towel—the one with his picture on it—that player wins.

But if it's not the pup's towel, leave it face up\* and all players continue playing until another player reaches the FINISH and tries to turn up the right towel. (The same player may try more than once to win: Don't spin, just turn over another towel.)

\* Note: Older players may add some challenge by turning the towel face down again so they have to remember which ones have been tried!

### **ASSEMBLY**

#### MAT:


To smooth out any creases or wrinkles in a brand-new mat, hold it with the fold mark(s) facing down and run the mat over a straight edge of a table.

# TUB:

- Insert battery: Unscrew the battery compartment door and insert 1 D-size battery (we recommend alkaline), being sure to align the + and - as marked in the plastic. Replace the door and the screw.
- Batteries may leak if improperly installed. Remove during extended storage.

2. Snap the Pup down into the main section of the tub, with his nose facing the bubble wheel, as shown. You will hear him "snap" into place.

- 3. Bubble wheel section: See below. Drop the light blue "bubble wheel" down into the smaller tub section, resting its central spoke on the protruding rest on the tub wall.
- 4. Bubble solution: Fill both parts of this front tub section with bubble solution, up to the "FILL LINE" markings.
  Note: You'll put more solution into the narrower part; this is where players dunk their wands before blowing their own bubbles.
- 5. Attach this section to the main tub, being careful not to spill any bubble solution. Note: To make them snap in easily, wipe a little bubble solution on the three round tabs first.



### **BUBBLE NOTES**

- If the tub isn't producing enough bubbles, it's probably time to add fresh bubble solution, or time to change the battery.
- If the bubbles all drift in one direction, check that you're not in a draft. Close a door or window if necessary.
- If you run out of the solution supplied, use any commercial brand (we recommend Imperial brand "Miracle Bubbles").
- Clean any bubble solution off play surfaces. (The soap in the solution could cause staining over time.)

# **RESTORAGE**

# Before packing up the game...

- Take off the front tub section and pour out all the bubble solution. Take the bubble wheel out, and wash it and the tub section under running water, then dry it gently with a paper towel.
- Wipe off the back tub section with a paper towel. Do not wash it, as it contains the motor.
- Rinse off the mat and wipe it dry.
