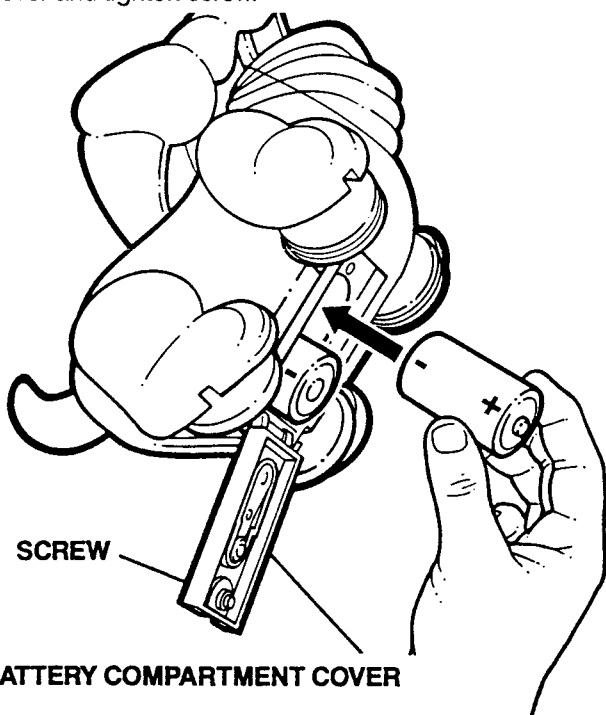


# Bubbles the Pup™

## BATTERY INSERTION

Turn Bubbles the Pup over and loosen large white screw on battery compartment cover, using screwdriver or coin. Open battery cover. Fit two fresh "D" alkaline batteries into battery compartment as shown. Correct battery placement is indicated on the bottom of the battery compartment. Close cover and tighten screw.



Regular screwdriver or coin required for battery placement (not included). Requires 2 "D" fresh alkaline batteries (not included). Bubbles solution not included.

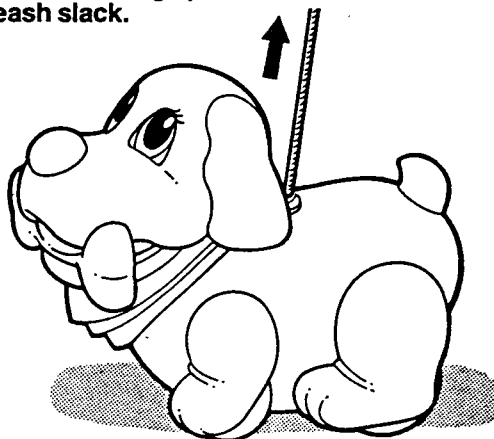
## NOTE TO PARENTS:

It may be necessary to show your child how to walk Bubbles the Pup for the first time.

## HOW TO WALK BUBBLES THE PUP

Bubbles the Pup will roll on most hard, flat surfaces, indoors or out. He will have difficulty rolling on rocky or sandy pavement.

To start the puppy, stand next to him and give a quick tug up on his leash. Now, keeping the leash slack, walk along with Bubbles the Pup, allowing him to roll about freely. To stop the puppy, give a quick tug up on the leash again. After five to ten minutes of parental instruction, it will be easy for most young preschoolers to learn how to tug up on the leash and walk, keeping the leash slack.



For best results, walk beside or behind the puppy. Pulling him while walking in front may cause him to tip over, and bubble solution may spill out. It may take a few seconds for the puppy to start blowing bubbles. Bubbles the Pup will walk with or without bubble solution in the reservoir.

## CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instructions.
2. Never mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
3. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.

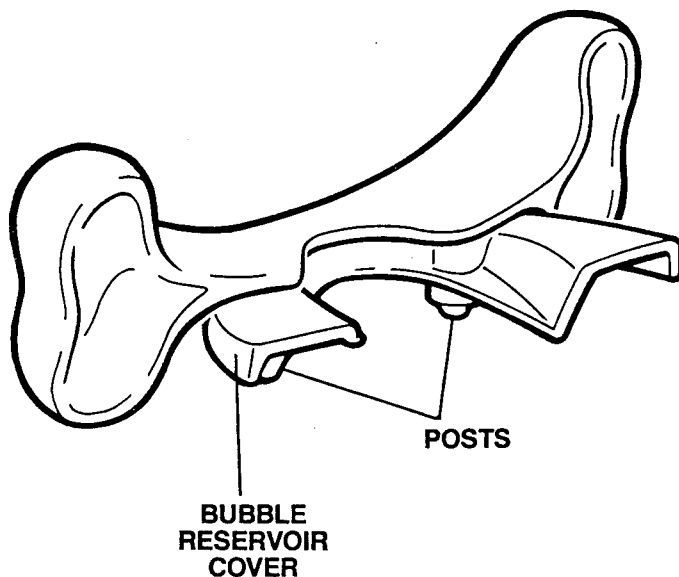

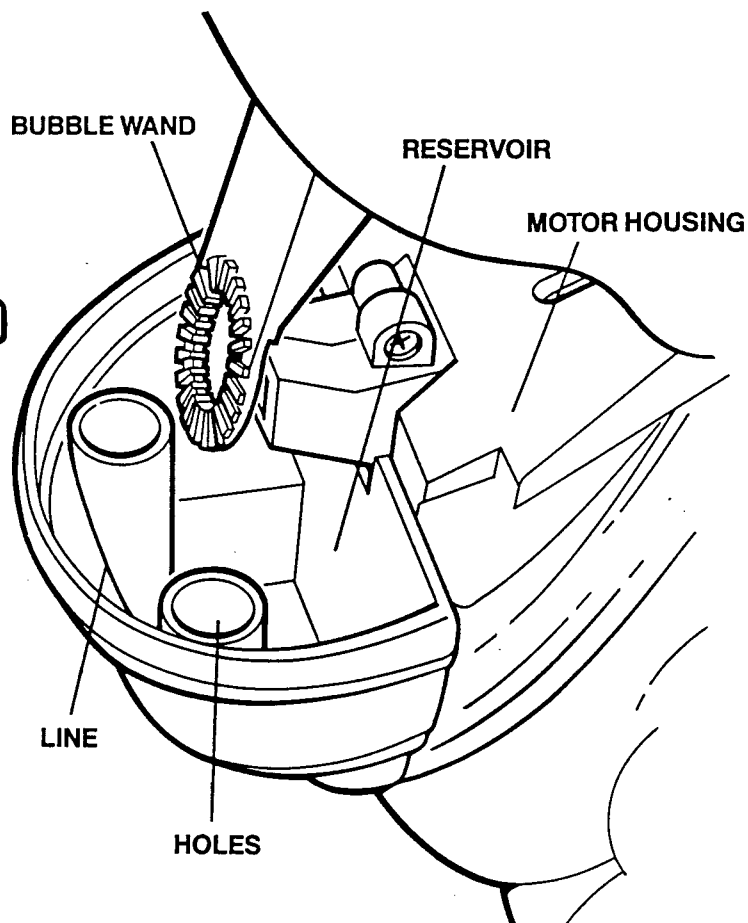

## GETTING STARTED



Pull up on bone in puppy's mouth to remove bubble reservoir cover. Fill reservoir in puppy's mouth with bubble solution to the line on the inside of his lower lip. You can use any store bought bubble solution. To replace cover, fit posts on bone into holes in puppy's mouth and press into place.



## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Before cleaning, always remove batteries and bubble reservoir cover. Avoid getting water inside battery compartment or motor housing.

To wash, rinse out reservoir in puppy's lower jaw, reservoir cover and bubble wand, using warm water. For best results, always rinse Bubbles the Pup™ thoroughly with clean water after use and before storing for long periods of time. Let the entire unit dry before reinstalling batteries.

## IF BUBBLES THE PUP DOES NOT BLOW BUBBLES

1. Check fluid level.
2. Discard used bubble solution and fill with fresh solution.
3. Bubble reservoir may need to be cleaned. See cleaning instructions.
4. Batteries may need replacement.

## NOTE TO PARENTS:

1. Do not use Bubbles the Pup in water.
2. During cleaning and filling, try to avoid spilling solution on the floor as it may create slippery floor conditions.
3. It is important that your child understands that bubble solution is the only substance that should be put into Bubbles the Pup.
4. Only use fresh bubble solution in Bubbles the Pup.

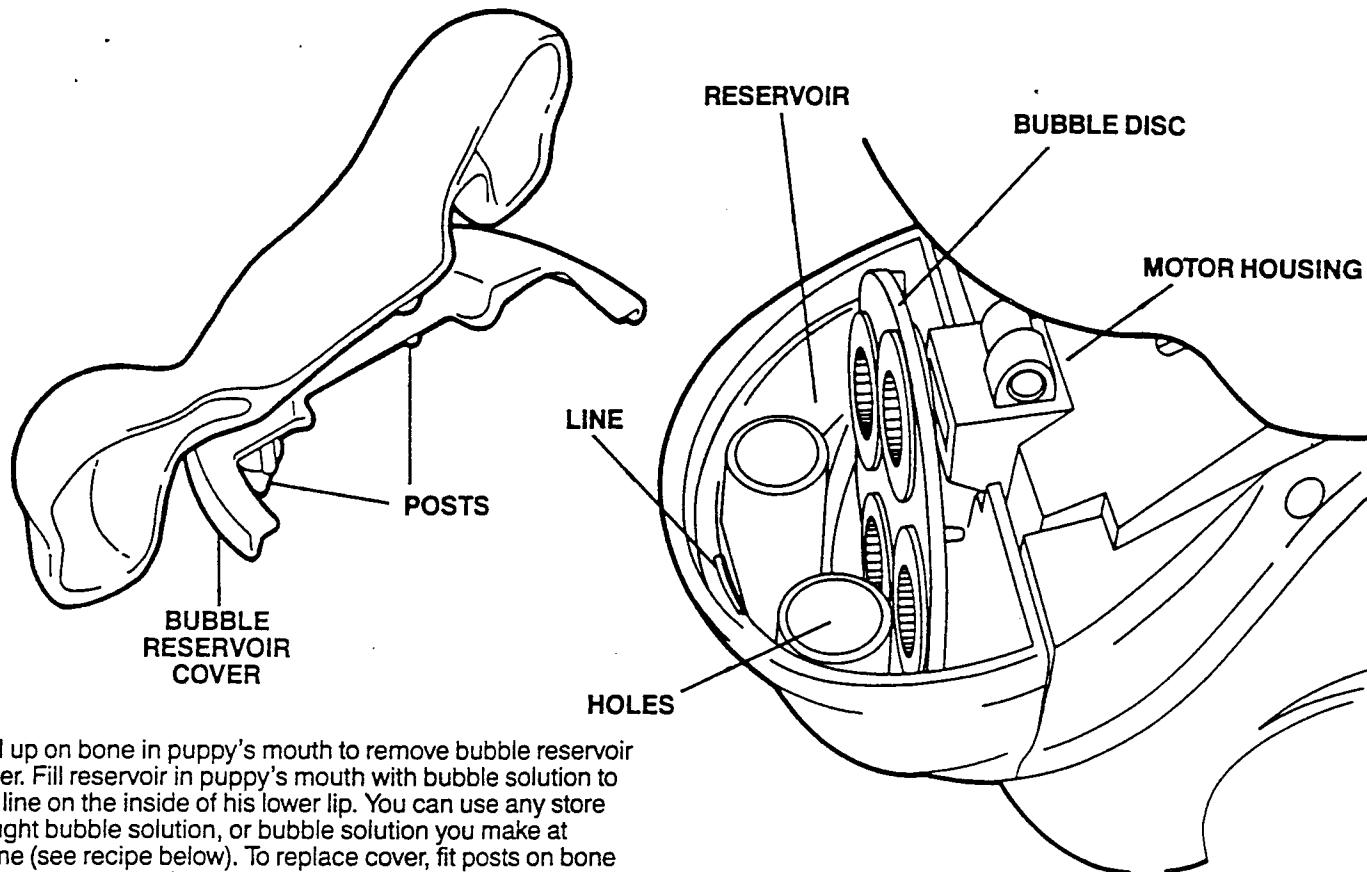

## GETTING STARTED



Pull up on bone in puppy's mouth to remove bubble reservoir cover. Fill reservoir in puppy's mouth with bubble solution to the line on the inside of his lower lip. You can use any store bought bubble solution, or bubble solution you make at home (see recipe below). To replace cover, fit posts on bone into holes in puppy's mouth and press into place.

## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Before cleaning, always remove batteries and bubble reservoir cover. Avoid getting water inside battery compartment or motor housing.

To wash, rinse out reservoir in puppy's lower jaw, reservoir cover and bubble disc, using warm water. For best results, always rinse Bubbles the Pup™ thoroughly with clean water after use and before storing for long periods of time. Let the entire unit dry before reinstalling batteries.

## IF BUBBLES THE PUP DOES NOT BLOW BUBBLES

1. Check fluid level.
2. Discard used bubble solution and fill with fresh solution.
3. Bubble reservoir may need to be cleaned. See cleaning instructions.
4. Batteries may need replacement.

## HOW TO MAKE BUBBLE SOLUTION

You can make your own bubble solution at home, using any quality dishwashing liquid (Joy® works best) and water.

1. Pour 2/3 cup of water into a clean pail. Add 1/4 cup of Joy® dishwashing liquid.
2. (Optional) Add 2 teaspoons of glycerine (available at most pharmacies). Glycerine makes the bubbles more durable by reducing evaporation.
3. Stir gently, trying to prevent foaming of the liquid.

## NOTE TO PARENTS:

1. Do not use Bubbles the Pup in water.
2. During cleaning and filling, try to avoid spilling solution on the floor as it may create slippery floor conditions.
3. It is important that your child understands that bubble solution is the only substance that should be put into Bubbles the Pup. This includes any commercially purchased bubble solution, or bubble solution you make at home.
4. Only use fresh bubble solution in Bubbles the Pup.
