



Rules for Playing **CHILDREN OF FOREIGN LANDS**

FOR 2 TO 6 PLAYERS



PREPARATION: Each player selects a Lotto Board. The picture cards are then shuffled and spread in the center of the table with the picture side down.

PLAY: The player to the left of the one who shuffled the cards draws a card first. If it matches one of the illustrations on his board, he places it on his board and draws another card. This same player continues to draw cards until he draws one which does not match the illustrations on his board. If one of the other players needs this card, he calls for it and also continues to draw and match as the previous player did. If the card drawn cannot be used by any player, it is returned to the table and the player to the left of the last player to play draws a card. The play continues in this manner until one of the players completely covers all the illustrations on his board and that player is declared the **WINNER**.
