

For 2 or More Players

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Have fun tapping out the blocks of ice, but don't let the little Iceman fall through. A little thinking will keep him from sinking, and you'll be the winner!

GETTING READY

Turn the game frame upside down and position the ice blocks in the frame with the open side of the blocks up. (The last one in every line has to be squeezed in.) Put the large block of ice into the frame too, any place you please. Turn the game frame over. Now seat the little Iceman in the holes on that large block and you're ready to play.

THE WAY TO PLAY

Take a mallet (share them if more than 2 of you play) and tap out a block of ice. You must continue with that same block until it falls through the frame, even though other blocks may fall before it or with it.

Take turns and use a little strategy because if the Iceman falls through the ice on your turn, you're out of the game. When that happens, set up the blocks for another round and start again.

If you're the last player left, after all the others have made the little Iceman fall through the ice, you win!
