

# Flat Folks™ Farm

## Instructions

**Ages: 2-6**

**Adult assembly is required.**

Before you start, remove all pieces from plastic bags.

**Includes** farm, tractor, ladder/conveyor belt, market sign, flat cow, flat horse, 4 connectible fences, 4 flat crops, 2 Flat Folks figures, 2 outfits, barn door, dutch door, garden wall and label sheet.

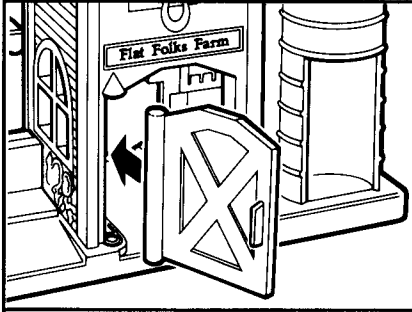
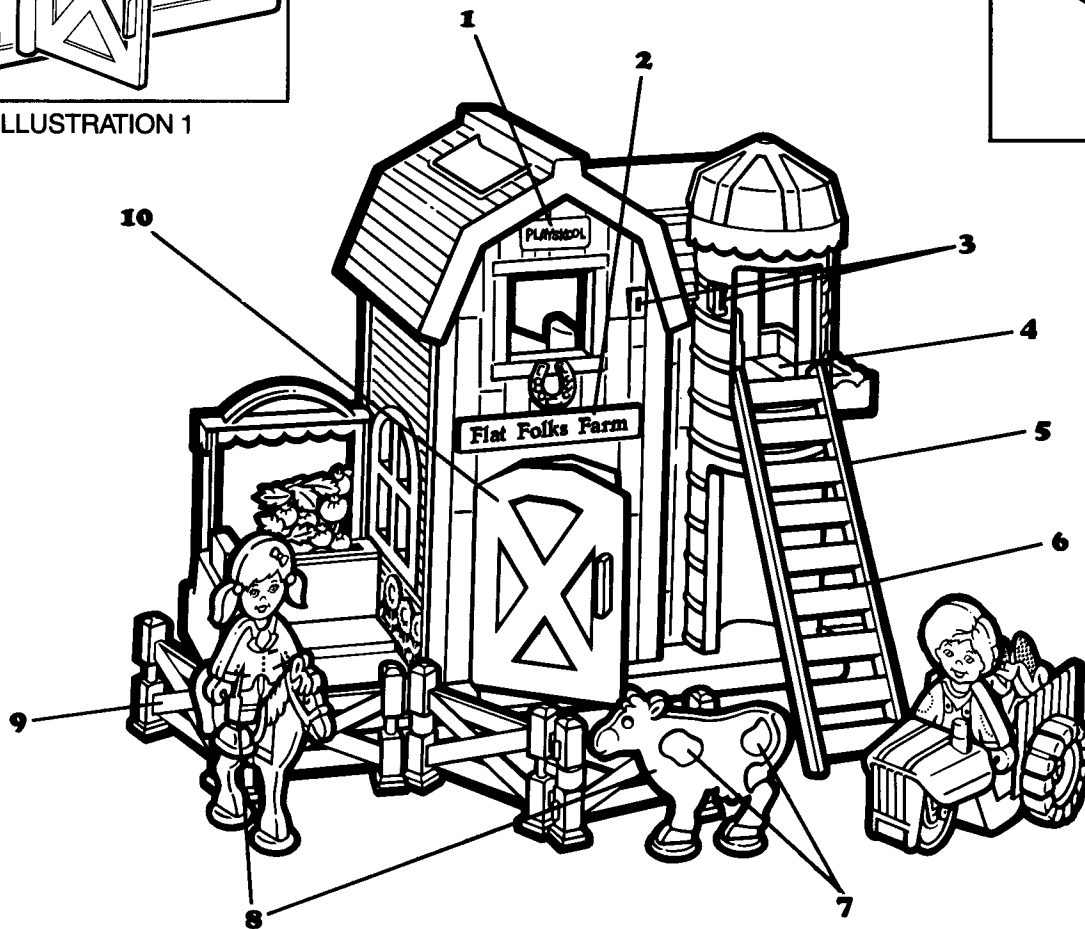
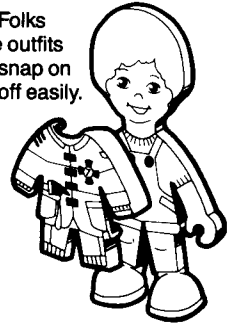


ILLUSTRATION 1

Flat Folks have outfits that snap on and off easily.



1. Put the Playskool logo here.
2. Place the Flat Folks Farm label here.
3. The posts on the ladder fit into the holes in the side of the barn for storage.
4. Flat Folks figures can slide down the silo.
5. Turn the ladder around and it's a conveyor belt.
6. The crops fit into the slots in the conveyor belt.
7. The labels on the cow's spots should look like this.  
NOTE: Be sure the shapes of the labels match the shapes of the grooves on the cow for a perfect fit.
8. The figures fit on the horse and the cow.

9. You can make a corral with the fence rails. NOTE: You may have to show your child how to connect the fences right side up.
10. To attach barn door, fit bump on bottom edge of door into groove in base of playset. Fit top edge of door into door jamb as shown. (ILL. 1)

**NOTE TO PARENTS:** The barn door, dutch door and garden wall are all specially designed to "break away" when too much force is applied. To reassemble, simply reattach as shown in these instructions.

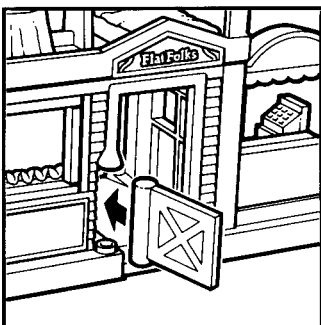

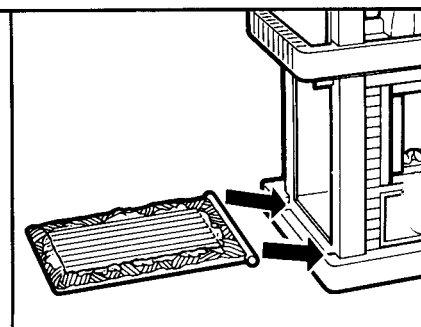
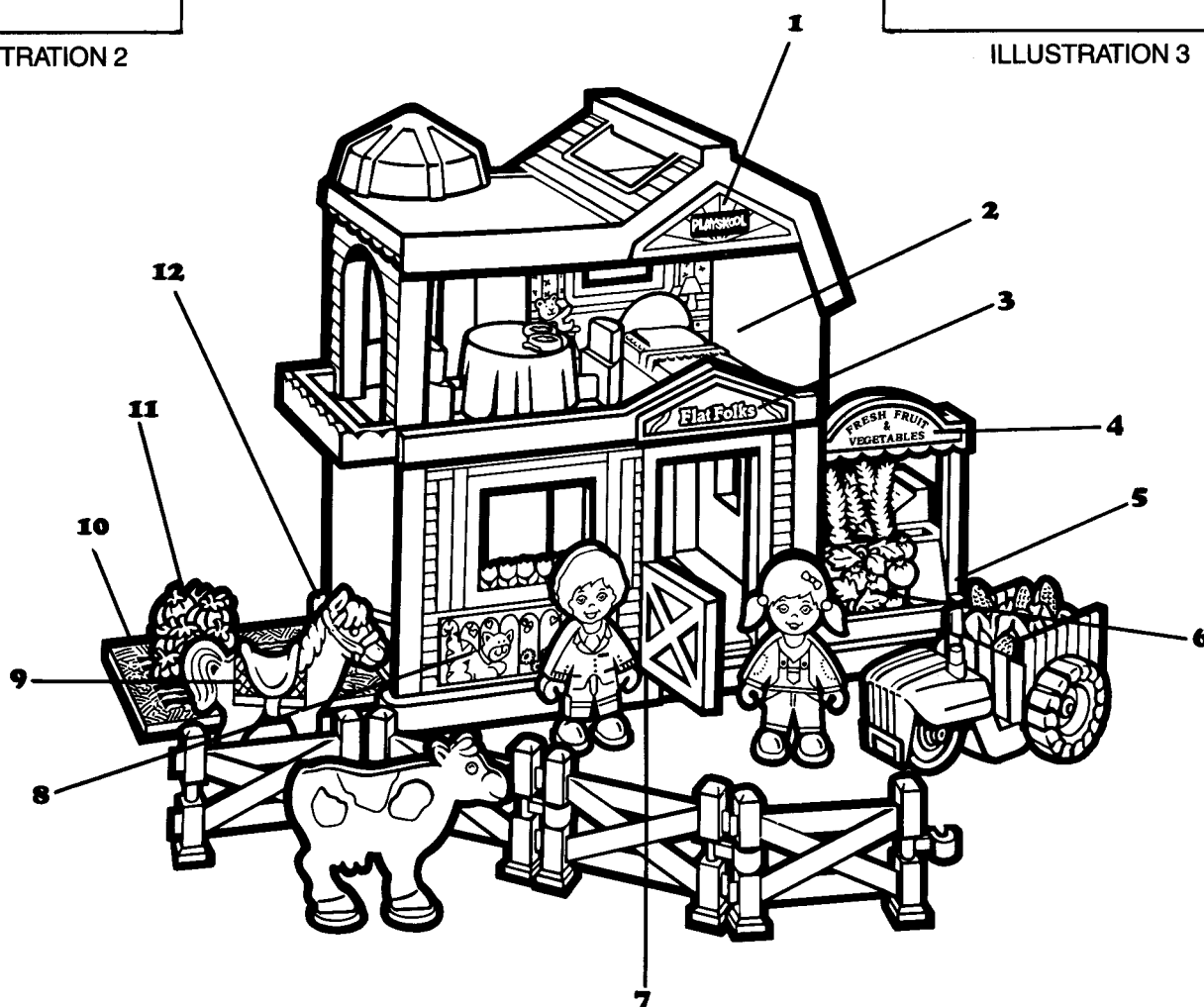


ILLUSTRATION 3



1. Place the triangular Playskool label here.
2. Store outfits next to the bed.
3. Put the Flat Folks label over the door.
4. Put the Fresh Fruit & Vegetables label here.
5. Fit the posts on the sign into the holes in the market stand.
6. Flat crops fit into the rack on the front of the stand.
7. Fit bump on bottom edge of Dutch door into groove in base of playset. Fit top edge of door into door jamb as shown. (ILL. 2)
8. Put the Cat and Fence label here.
9. Place the Horse Blanket labels on the horse as shown.  
NOTE: Be sure the shapes of the labels match the shapes of the grooves on the horse for a perfect fit.
10. Place the Cow label on the smooth side of the garden wall. NOTE: Be sure the label is positioned with the birdie on top and the posts on the wall at the bottom.
11. The flat crops fit into the slots in the garden.
12. To attach the garden wall, snap the posts into the holes in the side of the playset. (ILL. 3)
