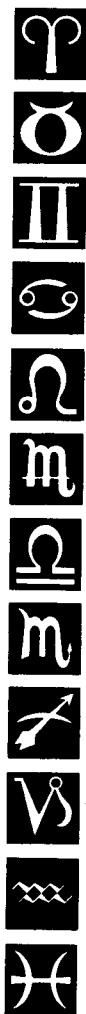

INTRODUCTION

Many centuries ago the Greeks carved the saying "Know Thyself" on the wall of the temple in Delphi. They considered it the essence of wisdom and a key to successful living. Plato, Juvenal and Emerson have quoted these words, and time has but added impact to their merit. Modern man seeks to follow this advice and welcomes all possible light on every factor that influences his life, and those of his fellow man.

It seems to me that each of us is somewhat like a beautiful musical chord. One note is determined by heredity; another is given its pitch by the environment into which we are born and reared. But there are other notes in our personal "Musical Chord" whose sources we may not recognize or understand, which I call "V.I.U.'s" — "Very Important Unknowns." Without such knowledge, one may find himself discordant rather than harmonious; carried about by a stream of events whose currents he has not charted and whose source seems hidden in mystery. So we are surely controlled by planetary and numerical influences as we are by those factors which are more clearly visible to us.

When it comes to venturing into the psychic world, you may be a nonbeliever. I happen to be a believer. I believe that there is a power greater than ours and that the entire universe is based on natural laws: heavenly bodies control our experiences and destinies; conscious and unconscious thoughts may be influenced by numbers.

NUMEROLOGY

"The world is built upon the power of numbers" — Pythagoras

Although Numerology has gained most of its present popularity within comparatively recent years, it is actually one of the oldest psychic sciences, dating back to many years before Christ. In a sense, numbers form a language in themselves. Conscious and unconscious thoughts are governed by the numbers, thus the number becomes a symbol of occult, mystical, or current event. The total of numbers in an individual's name give information on his personality, powers and future.

In keeping with the theory that "the world is built upon the power of numbers," — Pythagoras reduced the universal numbers to the figures 1 to 9. These are the primary numbers from which all others may be found and possess the following significance:

"1" is the number of great courage. It is evidenced by action, vision. From Ancient days it has been regarded as the symbol of light. Pythagoras considered "1" the sign of the Deity, for from it, we get all of the remaining numbers. Astrologians assign this numeral to the sun.

"2" is the number that stands for love and peace. It symbolizes unity and correlation, resulting in harmony. It balances everything and is ruled by tact, kindness and conventionality. Astrologically, "2" is associated with the moon.

A number becomes a symbol of a psychic, mystical, or current event while the sign under which one is born influences his personality. Although there have always been skeptics, (Cassius: "The fault, dear Brutus, is not in our stars but in ourselves, that we are underlings"), many people have tried successfully or unsuccessfully to explain away the strength of the heavenly bodies on our experiences and destinies. You, too, may be a skeptic. But when things seem beyond your control, don't you wonder?

For example, how do you explain away those painful periods when nothing but catastrophe strikes your financial and romantic life only to find your problems clearing up quite mysteriously? Or, how some people seem to have all the luck and you are the one who does not seem to get anywhere?

For thousands of years Numerology and Astrology have given answers to questions that continue to plague man. Astrology is the oldest of the sciences, and from it came mathematics, and the knowledge of the influence that numbers have on our lives, as well as their use as symbols in arithmetic. Now, with my Game of Destiny you can delve into the language of the stars and receive information on your own personality, powers and future. To some degree you will be able to discover what seems to be the answers to otherwise unexplainable courses of your own life. Sound interesting? It is, indeed!

"3" shows the versatility of a many sided nature. It is the number that symbolizes energy. Its action is derived through its association with the planet Mars. It is the number of progress.

"4" signifies the mind in action. It is associated with all creative work and the various functions of the intellect. It stands for attention to detail and, as well, for true friends and good company. "4" has been assigned to the planet Mercury, which is the symbol of great mind and force.

"5" is associated with adventure, expansion, and all good fortune. It has sacred significance, as shown by the five points of the pentagram. This number symbolizes understanding, judgment and sympathy. All activities that work toward aspiration. Astrologians regard "5" as the number of the planet Jupiter.

"6" is the symbol of stability. It is the number which produces connection between thought and action -- physical and mental. It is the linking number and, hence, is associated with love. Astrologically, it is connected with the planet Venus. It is in harmony with nature and brings to those influenced by it, success and great respect.

"7" symbolizes mystery and spirituality. It is the most mysterious of all numbers and has been used throughout recorded time as the number to express completion in all things spiritual. Astrologians assign this number to the planet Saturn. The number "7" is the Miracle number.

"8" is the number of material success. It stands for wealth and power. It has aggression and something of pomp about it. Astrological reasoning links "8" with the planet Uranus.

"9" is the symbol of universal achievement, the greatest of all primary numbers. It symbolizes the highest and most noble of man's aims. It combines features of the entire group, as well as having a mystical connotation. In astrology, the number "9" is associated with the planet Neptune.

ASTROLOGY

You will find that your own distinct personality traits are determined by the basic Zodiac signs under which you were born:

♈ **ARIES THE RAM** (March 21 - April 19): A natural leader of the Zodiac — pioneering, courageous, and dashing.

♉ **TAURUS THE BULL** (April 20 - May 20): A king maker rather than a king, he is more useful to others than he is to himself.

♊ **GEMINI THE TWINS** (May 21 - June 20): He is among the most changeable and unpredictable of signs, but excellent at diplomacy.

♋ **CANCER THE CRAB** (June 21 - July 22): Loyal and tenacious in love, he is completely family centered.

♌ **LEO THE LION** (July 23 - August 22): A master of all he surveys, Leo is most arrogant and dignified.

♍ **VIRGO THE VIRGIN** (August 23 - September 22): Here is the gift of intelligence — shrewdly analytical, logical and observant.

♎ **LIBRA THE BALANCE** (September 23 - October 22): A feeling for beauty, harmony and justice rules this Zodiac sign.

♏ **SCORPIO THE SCORPION** (October 23 - November 21): A creature of extremes, complete with dual personality, he is the strongest sign in the Zodiac.

♐ **SAGITTARIUS THE ARCHER** (November 22 - December 21): A half nominating half accepting sign — Sagittarius can either be pliant or aggressive.

♑ **CAPRICORN THE GOAT** (December 22 - January 19): Practical to the core, he is an accurate and dedicated worker.

♒ **AQUARIUS THE WATER BEARER** (January 20 - February 18): Sometimes called the sign of the genius, Aquarius is likely to be intellectual, original and unconventional.

♋ **PISCES THE FISHES** (February 19 - March 20): He is a dual nature. He is very honest — a leader among men. At times a little moody, and has musical talent.

What does all this mean to you? Simply this: not only does the date you were born influence your personality but you, as a person, were born with certain vibrations as depicted by your own personal number, and Zodiac Sign. You cannot change the nature of these vibrations nor can you redirect the mathematical and astrological powers that influence your life. God has given you free will to make decisions and those decisions, based on a knowledge of astrological and numerical influences, can be vitally important in directing the course of your life. Let my Game of Destiny help you find your personal number and astrological forecast.

JEANE DIXON GAME OF DESTINY

For 2 to 4 Players

TO SET UP THE GAME

1. **COMPUTING YOUR LUCKY NUMBER:** Each player takes a blue computation card. The cards are coated with a special plastic and should be written on in **PENCIL ONLY**. This special coating allows the cards to be erased and used again. Following the example in diagram 1, arrange your cards as follows:

- Write your first and last name on the top line. Count the number of letters written and enter the total in the column on the right.
- Write your date of birth in numerals on the second line. Now add the numbers across and enter the total in the column on the right.
- In numerals, write today's date on the third line. Again, total the numbers across and enter this figure in the column on the right.
- On the fourth line enter the time in numerals. Add the figures across and enter the total in the column on the right.

Add the figures in the column and enter the total in the space provided. **FOR NUMEROLOGY PURPOSES, ALL NUMBERS MUST BE REDUCED TO 1 DIGIT.** For example, if the numbers in the columns total 74, this number reduces to 11 ($7 + 4 = 11$) and the number 11 is again

reduced to the number 2 ($1 + 1 = 2$). When the figures have been reduced to a single digit number, this number becomes the player's **LUCKY NUMBER** for this particular round. This number should be kept in secret until the round is over.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

To collect a combination of cards containing your **LUCKY NUMBER** in order to get a numerology and an astrology reading.

- One player is selected as the dealer. He shuffles the playing cards and deals five cards to each player, one at a time, with the number side down. The remaining cards are placed in the center of the table, number side down. This deck becomes the draw pile.
- Each player in turn draws a card from the deck. If it is a card he needs, he places it in his hand and returns one of the cards from his hand into a discard pile, number side up.
- In a turn, a player may draw from either the draw or discard pile.
- The **DESTINY CARDS** are wild cards and may be used as any number.
- The **FATE CARDS** are used to combine numbers. If a player holds a **FATE CARD** he may use a combination of two cards to form his **LUCKY NUMBER**. This combination of three cards is equal to two number cards. **ALWAYS REMEMBER THAT TWO DIGIT NUMBERS ARE REDUCED TO A SINGLE DIGIT.**

Following is a list of combinations that may be used to form **LUCKY NUMBERS**.

To form number 1. 6 + 4 5 + 5 7 + 3 8 + 2 1 + 9
To form number 2. 1 + 1 2 + 9 3 + 8 4 + 7 5 + 6
To form number 3. 1 + 2 3 + 9 4 + 8 5 + 7 6 + 6
To form number 4. 1 + 3 2 + 2 4 + 9 5 + 8 6 + 7
To form number 5. 1 + 4 2 + 3 5 + 9 6 + 8 7 + 7
To form number 6. 1 + 5 2 + 4 3 + 3 6 + 9 7 + 8

To form number 7. 1 + 6 2 + 5 3 + 4 7 + 9 8 + 8
 To form number 8. 1 + 7 2 + 6 3 + 5 4 + 4 8 + 9
 To form number 9. 1 + 8 2 + 7 3 + 6 4 + 5 9 + 9

6. The first player to fill his hand with four cards of his **LUCKY NUMBER** with or without using destiny and fate cards is the winner of the round. Below are examples of winning hands for a **LUCKY NUMBER** five:

5 5 5 5 8

Fate 7 7 5 5

Fate 3 2 5 Destiny

7. The winner of the round now selects three of the five cards in his hand. (Use 2 "number" cards and one **Fate** or **Destiny** card if you have one.) He takes the vinyl card reader and places it in front of him with the printed side up. He now slides the three cards one into each slot. The cards should be placed into the slots with the Zodiac signs up. He now adjusts the cards until his birth sign appears in the window. Now turn the reader over and read the horoscope message.

8. After a player has won a round and read his horoscope message, he drops out of the game. The other players continue playing in rounds until each player receives a horoscope reading. When there is only 1 player remaining, he continues to draw and discard until he has the correct lucky number combination. He then proceeds as above to receive his horoscope reading.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

for readers of the Jeane Dixon Horoscope Column

Jeane Dixon's popular column appears in many newspapers throughout the country, reaching millions of readers. Perhaps you are one! If so, you may have noticed that her special **NUMEROLOGY MESSAGES** appear in it from time to time. They are meant for **YOU**, the players of her "**GAME of DESTINY**."

To obtain your **NUMEROLOGY MESSAGE**, compute your **DESTINY NUMBER** for that day (as outlined below) and look for that number in the column. The message that appears with that number is for you. The number may appear with **ANY** horoscope sign, not necessarily your own. If the number and your sign coincide, the message is especially meaningful for you.

HOW TO COMPUTE YOUR DESTINY NUMBER

STEP ONE — Record the numbers for your **NAME** and **BIRTH DATE**, as in the game instructions, rules 1a and 1b. Add them together and reduce to one digit.

STEP TWO — Record the **DATE** of the column in the paper and reduce it to one digit. Shuffle all the cards and place the pack on the table, number side down. Count off, from the top, the number of cards as the above **DATE** digit. For example, if the date digit was 7, count off 7 cards from the top. Turn over the next card and record its **NUMBER**. Note—"Fate" and "Destiny" cards are recorded as zero (0).

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STEP THREE — Add the number on this card to the digit from "step one" above. Reduce to a one digit number—your **DESTINY NUMBER** for Jeane Dixon's Horoscope column.

EXAMPLE OF A DESTINY NUMBER COMPUTATION

STEP ONE	— (Name)	John Robinson	12
	(Birth)	2-30-1930	18
		Add	30
		Reduced to	3

STEP TWO — (Column Date) 3-1-1969 29
Reduced to 11 then 2

Shuffle the cards, remove the top TWO, and turn over the next card. For purposes of this example, let's say it was a "5" card.

STEP THREE — Add 3 (from step one) and 5 (from step two) to equal "8".
Your **DESTINY NUMBER** for that date is 8.

Each reader must compute his own **DESTINY NUMBER** to obtain his message in that day's column.
