

THE GAME OF SQUARE MILES

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In playing this simple game, the players become acquainted with the comparative size of the various countries.

The **four key cards** are not used in this game.

Deal all the cards equally among the players, cards left over are not used.

Players do not look at the cards in their hand, and **MUST** hold them face down. All play the top card **face up** on to the center of the table, saying as he plays it "France 213,000 square miles," or "United States 3,027,000 square miles" as the case may be. The player whose card shows the largest area in **square miles** wins the trick. The player having the most tricks at the end of the game wins.
