OBJECT: Slap! Stand Up! Salute! Make the correct response to the royal family and friends—and be first to get rid of all your cards!

EQUIPMENT: 47 cards (Remove the coupon card from the deck.)

- If everyone responds correctly no one takes the pile.
- But if you reacted incorrectly, you must collect all the cards on the pile; turn them over and place them under the rest of your cards.
- If more than one player makes a wrong response, no one takes the pile.
- Play continues: The player to the left of whoever just went turns up a card.

SETUP: The youngest player deals the cards equally; place any leftovers aside, out of play. Stack your cards face down in front of you.

GAME PLAY for 3-6 players: The player to the dealer's left goes first: Turn over your top card (lift it away from you) and place it face up in the center of the table. Now, everybody, respond as quickly as you can to the turned-over card. See RESPONSES described inside this rules sheet.

WINNING: The first player to get rid of all of his or her cards wins!

FOR 2 PLAYERS: Go through your stack *once*, and keep collected cards *separate*. When both players' stacks are gone, count up your collected cards. The player with the fewest cards wins.

RESPONSES... Remember, all players respond to every card that's turned up!

The Knight: Thrust your right arm forward and shout, "Charge!"



The King: Stand up, at attention and salute the King!



The Joker: Slap one hand on the pile. The last hand on top takes the pile.



The Queen:
Pull on one ear
—and proclaim,
"Good evening,
Queen!"



The Friar:
Do nothing.
Say nothing.
(Don't be fooled!)



Jack: Wave your hand—and say, "Hi, Jack!"



The Princess:
Do nothing.
Say nothing.
(Don't be fooled!)
