

HARDY BOYS GAME

For 2 to 4 Players

This game is based on the T. V. adventure series, The Hardy Boys. The idea of the game is to solve the mystery of the Golden Idol by aiding the Hardy Boy's father-detective in piecing together the evidence in the case. There are short-cuts with pit falls and danger spots lurking about to hinder progress and add suspense.

TO START:

1. Separate cards from die-cut box tray.
2. Each player uses 4 matching color cards. The pawn of the same color is placed on the large circle in his corner.
3. Mix all the player's cards together and place them one at a time, face down, in each of the four corners of the playing board,

OBJECT OF THE GAME —

Find the four cards matching the color of your pawn.

TO PLAY:

1. High throw of dice plays first, play continues clockwise.
2. Players move their pawns along the blue circled path the number thrown. They attempt to arrive at any of the large blue circles to draw a card from the pile next to it and hope it is one of their color.
3. Players draw cards while face down and secretly so opponents cannot see whose card it is. If the player draws his own colored card he places it face up in front of him. If he draws an opponent's colored card he places it back, anywhere, in the face down pack.
4. The pawns may move in any direction but cannot move back and forth in one turn.
5. The first player to get all 4 cards of his color, puts them together. By restoring the idol he **WINS THE GAME.**
