

Rules for playing Holey Cow!™

Ages 3 to 6 For 2 to 4 players

Object

To be the first player to make his cow stand on its feet by placing four holey cows on his cow base.

Equipment

Sixteen holey cows, four cow bases, and one blue ribbon.

Preparation

Remove the cardboard sheets from the box and punch out the cows. Also punch out the holes where indicated. Scramble these cows and pile them in the center of the playing area. Each player takes one of the solid colored cows which have the pegs sticking up. A player is chosen to draw the first holey cow from the pile and the game is ready to begin.

The play

A player tries to fit one of the holey cow cards onto his cow. If it does not fit, he passes it to the player on his left who tries to place it onto his cow base. The cow card is passed around until one of the players matches it to his cow base. The first player to fit a cow card onto his base gets to draw the next cow card and he tries to match it to his base. If he cannot use this card he passes it around as before. The first player to get four cows onto his base, stands his cow upon its feet and he is the winner. The winner is awarded the blue ribbon.

If less than four people play Holey Cow™, some cows will not fit any of the player's bases. In this case, after all the players have tried to fit the cow onto their base, the cow is laid aside and the last player to try, draws another cow.
