For any number of players

## PREPARATION:

Place the game on the floor, or on a smooth surface indoors or out.

Agree upon a line behind which the players should stand when rolling.  
(By the edge of a table, edge of rug, piece of string, etc.)

## PLAY:

Choose the order of play and mark in this order the players' names on a piece of paper. Each player in turn then takes the three balls and **standing behind the rolling line** rolls one ball at a time into the panel. After the three balls have been rolled **once** the player's score is put on the piece of paper and the next player rolls.

## SCORING:

**ONLY BALLS WHICH GO INTO THE NUMBERED HOLES** in the scoring panel count. **NO OTHER BALLS SCORE.** Each ball is only rolled once on a turn. Players keep playing in turn until one player has a total score of 500 points. If players wish a longer or a shorter game, they should agree on a different total for the game before beginning to play. **HE IS THE WINNER!**
