In these remarkable puzzles adapted from her best-selling book LOOK-ALIKES, artist Joan Steiner has used hundreds of common everyday objects to create amazing, fool-the-eye scenes! You never know what items you'll find masquerading as other things in these whimsical creations.

First, complete the puzzle, then have even more fun trying to identify all of the Look-Alikes. It's a puzzle within a puzzle!

Be sure to try all of the other Hasbro puzzles with exciting scenes from LOOK-ALIKES: four different 550-piece puzzles for adults and four different 60-piece puzzles for kids.

HOW TO COUNT THE LOOK-ALIKES

1. If more than one of the same object is used to make up *one* look-alike (such as ten pencils making up a fence), it counts as *one* look-alike. But if the same or similar object appears elsewhere in the scene to make a different look-alike (such as a pencil appearing as a flagpole), it counts again.

2. Miniatures don't count as look-alikes unless they appear as something different from a larger version of themselves. For example, a toy car that represents a real car is not a look-alike. But a toy car that looks like a fire hydrant *does* count.

3. As long as you can identify an object, you don't have to get the name exactly right.

4. Asterisks indicate hard-to-find items—for supersleuths only!

CIRCUS ANSWERS

100 Look-Alikes

TENT

Trenchcoat, pair of pants, large zipper (on right), American flag (partly behind band), small plastic bandage, paper doll outfit, fishhook with lure, silver evening purse*, pearl sweater clasp.

TENT POLES, RIGGING, AND LIGHTS

Up high, left to right: red and blue valve handles, arrows, two skirt hangers, covered hook-and-eye, alligator clips*, knitting needles, hoop earrings*, large bobby pin, safety pins, lanyard clasp, beaded chain (aerialist's ladder), carpenter's clamp, beaded necklace (aerialist's rope), domino, door latch hook, drop earring, sewing needle, cheese slicer, yardstick (tent pole, right foreground). **Trapezes:** cord necklace with pendant, barrette, eyeglass strap, cotton swab. **Lower down, left to right:** bulldog paper clips, pencils, fishhook and lure, chopsticks, gold-edged ribbon (ladder), brass paper fasteners, corncob holders, candy-coated chocolates, faucet aerator, vegetable peeler, blue pencil-tip erasers, billiard cue chalk, toy googly-eyes, aspirins, (another fishhook and lure), hook (hook and eye type), binder clips. **Technician's platform:** pushpins, wristwatch face, blue pet halter, bottle cap, roll of film, paper clamp*, track for model train.

SURROUNDING THE RING

Striped birthday candles, alphabet stencils, audiocassette, matchboxes, wooden matches. **Band:** paper fastener box, eye shadow applicator, spools of thread. **Entranceway:** model train boxcar, party blow-out toys, star-shaped candleholder, small yellow candle, peacock feathers, tiny gold safety pins, dollar bills (rug). **Calliope:** toy flutes, protractor, pen nibs, flagpole finial*, toy bullet, old-fashioned key, yellow paper clips, corn kernels, penny, harmonica, binder clip (hitch).

RING AREA AND PERFORMERS

Animal Stands: cupcake paper, rubber band, wooden block (far right). **Ring:** tickets, cap-gun caps, straw place mat, patchwork hot pad, champagne cork cages. **Springboard:** artist's sandpaper pad, silver snap. **Floor:** silk scarf, paper bags. **Crown:** tiny spiral seashell, ponytail holder, tubes of paint.

Aerialist: fake fingernails. **Harlequin girl:** terry ponytail cinch, purple silk flower, garlic cloves.

HOTEL ANSWERS

117 Look-Alikes

TOP OF WALL

Wooden spoons, cardboard matches, accordion peg coatrack, unbleached coffee filters, wine cork, pretzels, yardsticks, folding knives (archway on right).

SHOP WALL ON LEFT

Five-dollar bill, jigsaw puzzle pieces, cigarillo, spiral seashell, golf tee.

BACK WALL

Chocolate bars, crayons. **Marble pillars:** buttons, map sections, rubber bands*, sandwich cookies. **Arch:** fancy hair clip. **Sculpture on wall:** polished pebble, beige chess pawns, spiral cookies, corn kernel, night-light fixture, biscotti cookie. **On stairway wall:** feather fishing lure, stone arrowhead.

embroidery hoop, artificial leaf, shade pull, pencils. **On upper landing wall:** tea ball, metal bookend, kitty litter scoop, squishy fish fishing lure, cup hook, pinecone*.

RESTAURANT

Lace fan, white nylon gloves, six-pack plastic rings, toy green plastic dinosaurs, crystal doorknob, toilet plunger, small wooden scoop, hairpins, cupcake papers, tiny artificial flowers (lampshades)*, brass paper fasteners (vases)*, acorn (chicken), thimble, nailbrush.

OBJECTS IN FRONT OF BACK WALL

Razor, crossword puzzle, bullets, gold-toned coins*, meat thermometer, hoop earring, hose nozzle, comb, graham crackers, rubber stamp, Christmas ball, chess knight, jumbo sidewalk chalk, wooden crochet hook, plastic cocktail forks, shaving brush, ivory-colored dominoes.

HANGING LAMPS

Ballpoint pen with top, doorbell, votive candle, bicycle sprocket, silk flowers.

LOUNGE AREA

Pennies, pea pods, ceramic napkin ring, coin purse, bobby pins (on front of chair arms)*, restaurant coffee creamer, saltshaker, shoe-polish tin, lamp socket, orange suede gloves, postage stamps, picture frame, spool of gold thread, gold-foil-wrapped chocolate coin, bars of soap (two sizes), camouflage cloth, autumn leaves, dried maple-seed cases, doily, red and natural pistachio nuts, feathers.

RECEPTION AND ELEVATOR AREA

Silver pepper mill, lavender ponytail elastic*, black chess pawn, oven thermometer, old-fashioned key, museum admission tag, marble-based desk pen set, peacock feather*, leather wallet, chopsticks, unopened tube of flypaper, dog chews, toggle buttons, nutmeg grater, plastic protractor,

window lock, clear ballpoint pen, table knife, silver crochet hook, wooden switch plate, single-edge razor blades, card of thumbtacks.

CANOPY

Garden rake, bullets, Christmas ornament.

BUILDINGS TO LEFT OF INTERSECTION

Building on left-hand corner: green suitcase, mousetraps, pistachio nuts (red and natural), toy trumpet Christmas ornament, staple remover, pastels, honey dippers, recorders, handcuffs, cupcake papers, bottle cap, toothbrush-and-cup holder, artist's knives, pearl earrings, blue crayon, uninflated pink balloon, drill bit, travel soap dish with soap, pearl anklet, roll of candy, spools of thread, roll of cap gun caps, birthday candle holder, sticks of gum*, whistle, price stickers, doll shoes, toy wooden geese, cap guns, nuts and bolts.

BUILDINGS AND THINGS SEEN THROUGH INTERSECTION

Bus: carpenter's clamp, audiocassette, clear button*. **Building behind bus:** champagne cork, rubber stamp, Scrabble tile, baseball card*, paint stirring stick. **Blue-roofed building and behind it:** billiard cue chalk, matchboxes, phone jack, blue pencil-tip erasers, spiral notepad, posable sculptor's mannequin, saltshaker top, hourglass egg timers, ballpoint pen and holder, folding carpenter's ruler*, wafer cookies. **Church:** pen nibs, brown pencils, chocolate chips, metronome, chess king, wedding band*, penny, purse, small bottles, chess pawns, bobby pins*, file folders, newspaper, plastic cocktail forks, tape measure, buttons, pecans, breakfast cereal hexagons. **Truck:** packets of sewing needles. **In intersection:** punch-type can opener, candy-coated chocolates,

drafting compasses, pearls, small yellow pencils, fishing line weights, clothing label, small chalkboard, lentils.

RESTAURANT BUILDING

Book, bell, chess bishops, paintbrushes, alphabet noodles, nutcracker, cable-knit sweater, black-eyed peas, fancy toothpicks, corn kernels, pushpins, pretzels, peanut, safety pins, clothespins, dog biscuits, price tags, dollar bills, matchbook, blue birthday candles, silver dollars (tables), electrical connectors (vases)*, champagne cork cages, paper clips, melba toasts. **Signpost on corner:** glass cutter.

DELICATESSEN BUILDING

Supermarket bonus stamps, jigsaw puzzle piece, cigarillo, ruler, shade pull, dried maple-seed cases, saltines, chopsticks, incense sticks, gum erasers, wool label, postage stamps, paint chip strip, emery board, miniature water-color kits, cereal o's, plastic protractor, pet collar, tiny buckles, luggage tag, diamond ring, thimbles, candy corn, nail clippers, drop earring, candy in wrapper, pinecone, bingo game cards, alphabet blocks, yellow pencil sharpener, spool of red thread, die, TinkerToy part, red bouillon cube*, seashell, button*, swizzle stick, toy car. **Signposts in front of deli building:** machine screw, large nail, museum admission tag, digital watch face, bulldog paper clip, bread closure tag, screwdriver, nut (nut-and-bolt type).

TOY SHOP BUILDING

Shutter, Scrabble board, knitting needle, cocktail forks, comcomb holder, plastic bandage, red crayon, Chinese finger puzzle, hair clip, jack (from game of jacks), wooden match, postage stamp, chess knight, barrette, corn kernels, pistachio nut, spiral pasta, seashell, ball-headed pin, model train freight car. (Note: Puppet is a miniature rather than a look-alike.) **Hydrant:** roll of film, snap, saltshaker top.

CAR:

Black shoe, mushrooms, sewing needle, zipper slide, acorn, silver barrettes, key chain clasp (door handle)*.

FOREGROUND AND STREET

From left: dominoes, checkerboard, lollipop, chocolate sandwich cookie, dime, ceramic napkin ring, meat thermometer, nickel, ice cream cone, dress pattern (roadway), photographic slide (grating in road). **Figures in foreground:** white seashell, peanut.

TRAIN ANSWERS

126 Look-Alikes

LOCOMOTIVE

Front of engine: coffeepot, overalls buckle, bingo call number, nuts (nut-and-bolt type). **Cowcatcher:** toy truck, harmonica, nail clipper, red cocktail fork, package carrying handle, red birthday candle. **Lower engine and wheels:** cap guns, roll of film, battery, black ballpoint pen cap*, toy handcuffs, wristwatch face, toy compass, drafting compass with pencil, matchbook, can opener, green pencil-top eraser, wrenches, cat food cans, bottle tops, (more bingo call numbers), spark plug, tire pressure gauge, die, small calculator, candy thermometer, hacksaw, pencil sharpener, buckle, bottle stopper, pencil, felt-tip marker, bouillon cubes. **Upper engine:** spool of thread, postage stamp, metal spring toy, sink plug, small jar of honey, knitting needle, green button, electrical connectors (holding knitting needle), sewing needles in paper. **Cab:** child's sandals, carpenter's clamp, pushpins, subway token, hinge, photographic slide, big safety pin, old-fashioned keys.

REST OF TRAIN

Coal carrier: pocketbook, green padlock, two books, toy car, ballpoint pen refill, corkscrew/bottle opener, can/bottle opener, jar tops*,

sewing machine bobbins. **Freight car:** cardboard box, steak knives, swizzle sticks, spiral notepads, rubber bands, balsa airplane parts, toy pilot's wings*, toothpick, wooden match, crochet hook, twist ties, price tag, orange ticket, tape measure, tiny plastic clothespin, small clasp envelopes, orange cocktail forks, theater ticket voucher, green comb, domino*, green alphabet letters, key holder, bulldog paper clips*, dollar bill. **Passenger car:** six-pack box, six-inch ruler, wristwatch band, paper clip, carpenter's clamp*, razors (steps)*, ring, luggage tag*, toy wooden animal.

WATER TOWER

Sifter, dollar bill, wooden cocktail forks, chopsticks, wire whisk, rubber stamp handle, needle and thread, weighted fishhook.

TRACKS, OVERPASS, AND FOREGROUND

Screwdriver, TV antenna, chopstick*, cinnamon sticks, food grater*, twelve-inch ruler, jigsaw puzzle pieces, stapler, guitar case, pinecones, potatoes, pecans.

SMOKE AND SKY

Cotton, white rose, toy bunny, baby bootie, pearl earring, baby tooth, jingle bell, button, seashell, pearl, snap.
