

#### NOTE TO PARENTS


Inside the coated rocks are semi-precious stones that have been cut and polished, and a Magic School Bus toy. The stones and bus are small parts and represent a choking or inhalation hazard to children under 4 years of age. The coating of each rock, which dissolves in water, contains a nontoxic but badtasting ingredient designed to make children remove the rock if they should ever place one in their mouths. To avoid that possibility, keep the rocks away from children under 4.


### To Reveal The Coated Rocks





1. Remove rocks from display caseby grasping corner of case and lifting top.












2. Remove plug from tumbler and place up to 5 coated rocks into the container. Fill with warm water until tumbler is about one-third full. Cover opening with plug.


3. Place tumbler onto base, with grooves in tumbler resting on curved sides of base as shown. While holding base in place, turn tumbler knob to spin the tumbler. After just a few minutes of spinning the tumbler, the coated rocks will magically transform into beautiful stones! (Along with the stones, you will also reveal one Magic School Bus.)

NOTE: The length of time for revealing the rocks will vary depending on the size of the rock, temperature of the water and number of rocks in the tumbler.

4. Take tumbler and base to a sink. Drain water from tumbler and empty any water that may have leaked from tumbler into trough around base. Look at the beautiful, semi-precious quartz stones! (Be careful not to pour


them down the drain!)
Repeat process
for the other

coated rocks.




## To Label & Display Your Stones


1. Remove label card from display case. Using the place mat/rock guide to identify your newly revealed stones, label each stone in the space provided on card.









2. Open display case and place card into the case so that the labels on the card are aligned with the indented holders on the case as shown. With the card held flat, place stones onto the card under the proper label. Snap indented holder side of display case over card and rocks.







3. To display your new stone collection, stand case on end (using base for support), as shown. Check to see that each rock is correctly labeled in the space above it.



4. Additional stickers are included to label new stones you may add to your collection. The stickers may also be used to to change the existing labels on the card.
