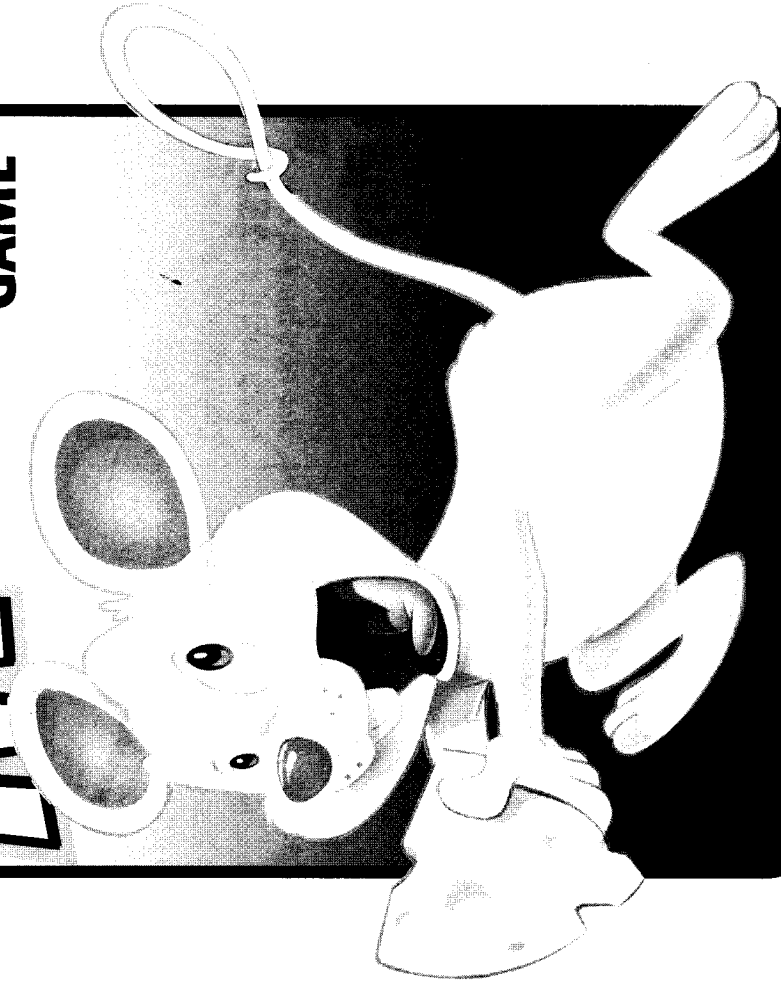

20 Cardboard cheese pieces,
4 Mouse catchers, Label sheet

The First Time You Play

Attach Labels

1. Remove parts from box and discard all wrapping materials including plastic bag.
2. Apply the eye labels to the mouse as shown in Figure 1.
3. Apply one cat paw label to each of the four mouse catchers as shown in Figure 2.

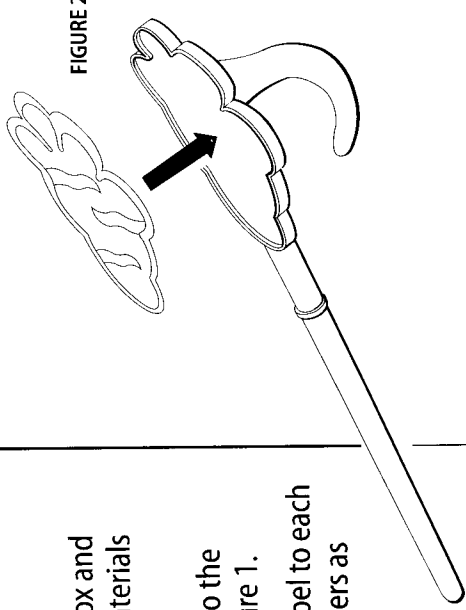

Get Your Cheese

Carefully punch out the 20 pieces of cheese from the cardboard sheet. Discard cardboard waste.

Insert Batteries

1. Make sure the mouse is turned off by pulling the mouse's tail back to the OFF position as shown in Figure 3.

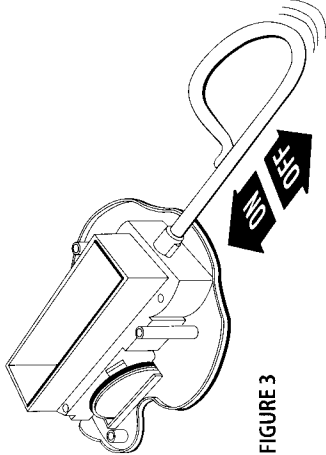

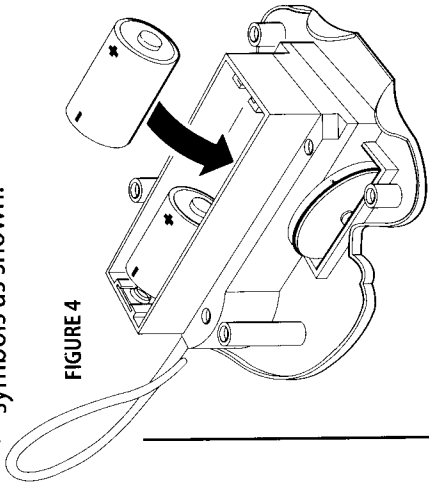

2. Insert two "C" size alkaline batteries into the battery box as shown in Figure 4. Be sure to match the "+" and "-" battery symbols as shown.

Mouse Assembly

1. Turn the mouse's body upside down. Use a Phillips head screwdriver to remove the four screws from the mouse as shown in Figure 5.

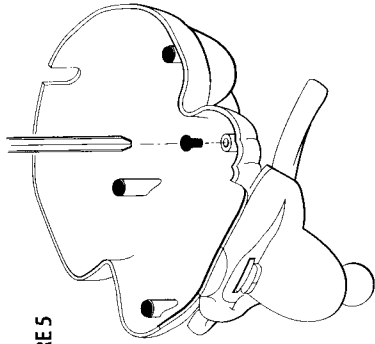
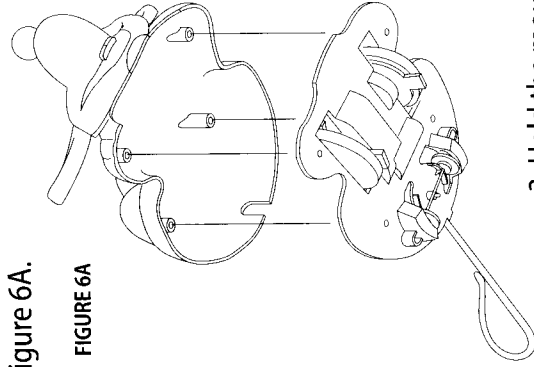

2. Turn the mouse's body right-side up and place it onto the wheel base as shown in Figure 6A.

3. Hold the mouse body and the base together and turn upside down. Attach the base to the mouse's body with the four screws as shown in Figure 6B.

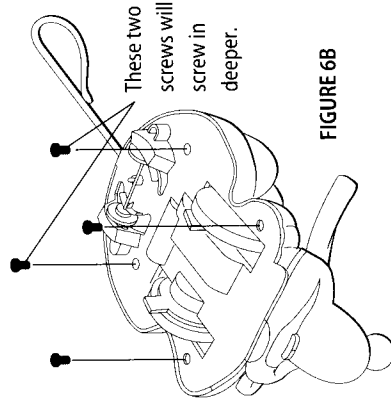

Testing the Batteries

Turn the mouse rightside up and place it on the floor. A hard floor or low-pile carpeting works best. Hold onto the mouse and push in the tail to the ON position. See Figure 7.

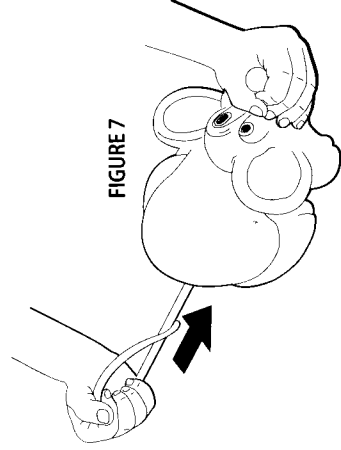

Immediately after pushing in the tail, let go of the mouse. It should begin moving quickly around the floor. If it doesn't, the batteries may be weak or improperly installed. Pull the tail back to the OFF position when done.

Caution: Batteries may leak if improperly installed. Remove batteries during extended storage. Never mix battery types.

Object of the Game

Be first to collect four pieces of cheese from the mouse.

Getting Ready to Play

1. Each player takes a mouse catcher.
2. Place one piece of cheese firmly into the mouse's mouth as shown in Figure 8. Place the remaining cheese pieces out of the way.
3. Place the mouse on the floor in a wide-open area.

The Chase Begins! (How to Play)

1. One player pushes in the mouse's tail to the ON position.
2. As soon as the mouse has turned one full circle, all players quickly try to grab the mouse by the tail using the hooks on their mouse catchers. See Figure 9. No fair using your hands to grab the tail!

Careful! Don't let the mouse touch you! If it does, you must give up a piece of cheese (if you have one).

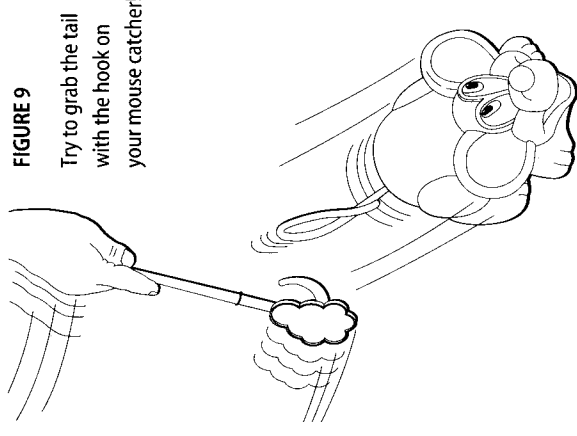

Try to grab the tail with the hook on your mouse catcher!

Note: If the mouse drops its cheese during the game, leave the cheese where it fell and continue the chase. The player who catches the mouse wins the piece of cheese as described above.

5. Now take another piece of cheese from the pile and place it in the mouse's mouth. Place the mouse back on the floor, push in the tail to the ON position and continue gameplay as described above.

Winning the Game

Be the first player to get four pieces of cheese and you win! Congratulations! You're the BIG CHEESE!

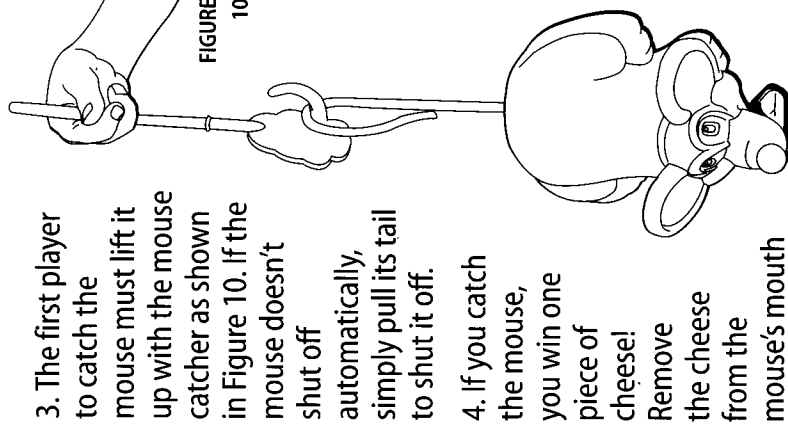

3. The first player to catch the mouse must lift it up with the mouse catcher as shown in Figure 10. If the mouse doesn't shut off automatically, simply pull its tail to shut it off.

4. If you catch the mouse, you win one piece of cheese! Remove the cheese from the mouse's mouth and slide it onto the handle of your mouse catcher as shown in Figure 11.

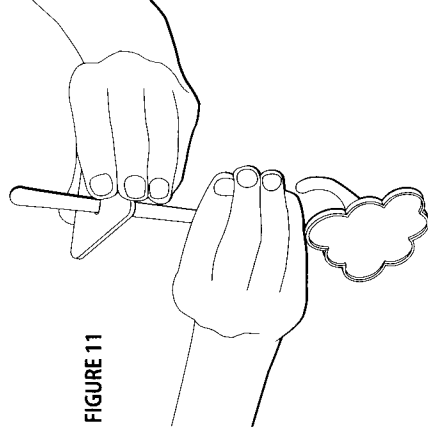
