CONTENTS: 39 playing cards, rules card. Note: There are 19 pairs, numbered 1 through 19, plus Minnie with her Old Maid mask.

OBJECT: To get rid of all the cards in your hand by discarding matching pairs — and not be stuck holding the last card, Minnie Mouse with her Old Maid mask!

SETUP: Shuffle. Starting to the dealer's left, deal out all the cards, one at a time, face down. (Hold your cards with the notch in the upper right and the characters facing you.)

PLAY: If you have any pairs (two cards with the same number and the same character), lay them face up in the middle of the table. All players do the same. The youngest player goes first; play passes to the left.

On your turn:

- Pick one card at random from the hand of the player on your right. (The cards are being held with their backs towards you.)
- If the card you pick matches a card in your hand, lay the pair down on the table, face up. Your turn ends.
- If the card doesn't match, add it to your hand. Your turn ends.
- When you have matched and laid down all the cards in your hand, CONGRATULATIONS! You did not get stuck holding Minnie Mouse with her Old Maid mask! Relax and watch the rest of the game.

ENDING THE GAME: Play continues until everyone has an empty hand — except the person who is stuck with the one remaining card. That person is the "Old Maid"!
