


Pleting Elling



CONTENTS:

2 red gameboards with 21 red-colored picture cards; 2 blue gameboards with 21 blue-colored picture cards

OBJECT:

Be the first player to fill in the eight card spaces on your two gameboards in this frantic hunt-and-match game.

SETUP:

- 1. One player is the Blue Player; the other player is the Red Player. The Blue Player takes the two blue-bordered gameboards; the Red Player takes the two red-bordered gameboards.
- 2. Spread the cards out FACEDOWN in the center of the table—within easy reach of both players. Then mix them up. (NOTE: The cards are stored below the cardboard platform.)
- 3. Leave the game box nearby to place any cards out of play during the game.

GAME PLAY:


One player says, "One, Two, Three—GO!" On the word "GO!", both players, at the same time, each quickly pick a card from the center pile and try to match it to the color of their gameboards. If you're the Red Player, you're hunting for the red cards. If you're the Blue Player, you're hunting for the blue cards.

- ♦ If you draw your color card, start hunting right away for the matching object on your gameboards!
- ♦ If you don't draw your color card, return the card FACEDOWN to the pile and pick another card.

How To Match A Card To Your Gameboards:

Sometimes the match will be easy to find. At other times, the matching object will be harder to spot. You might even find some hiding in the border of your gameboards!

When you find the match, shout "I found it!" and place that card FACEUP on an empty card space on that gameboard. See Figure 1.



If you find the match but all of your card spaces on that gameboard are full, place that card out of play inside the game box.

If you do NOT spot the match right away, place that card FACEUP next to your gameboard. You may be able to match it later.

Continue picking and matching cards as quickly as you can!

WINNING THE GAME:

If you are the first player to fill all eight card spaces on your two gameboards, shout "I win!"
