



Real Sounds Kitchen Set™

Includes: Dishwasher/counter unit, toaster, kitchen chair, bowl, plate, dish rack, dish towel.

Tool needed for battery replacement: Philips screwdriver.

Inserting Batteries





1. Locate battery compartment in back of counter. Use a Phillips screwdriver to loosen screw, and remove battery door. Insert 2 "AA" batteries (alkaline recommended) as shown, then replace door and tighten screw.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- 1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Never mix old batteries with new batteries, or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is stored for a long period of time.

Assembly


1. Attach the longer post to the counter unit as shown, pressing the post up into the fitting on bottom of counter.





Play Instructions


1 Place the dishes in the dish rack as shown in illustration, then put the rack inside the dishwasher and close the dishwasher door.



2. Now press the heart button to hear realistic dishwasher sounds! Each time you press the button, the electronic sounds will go through a whole dishwasher cycle - rinse, wash, rinse, dry! (Once the cycle starts, the sounds cannot be stopped or interrupted.)




3. Lift the lever on the toaster to make the pretend toast pop up!
