

OBJECT

To move your token across the finish line first by guessing the answers to Rich Little's charades and to the Solo charades in less time than the Pro team.

EQUIPMENT

120-minute video cassette • game board
• 3 tokens: 1 large and 2 small

SET UP

1. Turn on the TV and the VCR unit and insert the charades video cassette.
2. Choose one player to control the tokens on the game board and be the timekeeper. Place the small tokens behind the START line. Place the large token in the center of the board.

- SMALL TOKENS: Choose one of the small tokens to represent your **Home team**. The other small token will represent the **Pro team**.
- LARGE TOKEN: The large token is used during game play to indicate the TV clock reading at the time of the Home team's complete answer. (See *PLAYING* section, #3.)

Note: The timekeeper will need a watch or a clock with a second hand for timing Solo charades. (See *PERFORM A SOLO CHARADE* section.)

3. Choose a player to do the first Solo charade. Play passes, in turn, to the *left*.
4. If you are playing the game for the first time, start the video cassette at the beginning for an overview of game play.

PLAYING

1. Start the video cassette and advance it to the first numbered charade you have not previously done. (All of the charades are sequentially numbered in the right-hand corner of the screen.) When all the players are ready to begin, play the tape.
2. By guessing aloud at the same time, both the Home team and Pro team try to answer each part of the charade as Rich Little performs it.

Note: The Home team should interpret the sign language and listen to the Pro team's guesses while watching Rich Little's reactions to them.

3. As soon as the Home team guesses the complete charade, the timekeeper notes the time shown in the lower left-hand corner of the screen. He or she then places the large token on the corresponding number on the game board.

Note: The Home team may change its answer as many times as it wishes, UNTIL THE PRO TEAM ANSWERS CORRECTLY. However, each time a different answer is given, the large token must be moved to the number

on the game board that corresponds to the time displayed in the lower, left-hand corner of the screen.

4. When the correct answer to the charade is given by the Pro team, record the score as described in the *SCORING* section.
5. When scoring is complete, you'll begin a new round with the next Rich Little charade, or with a Solo charade.

SCORING

The team to answer the charade first wins the round and has its token moved ahead on the game board. The timekeeper moves that team's token ahead the number of spaces equal to the time of their correct answer.

PRO TEAM: The clock on the screen flashes as soon as the Pro team answers correctly. If the Home team has not given a complete answer by then, the Pro team wins the round and its token is moved ahead the number of spaces equal to the time on the clock.

HOME TEAM: If the Home team answers correctly before the Pro team, its token is moved ahead the number of spaces indicated by the large token on the game board.

PERFORM A SOLO CHARADE

When either the Home or the Pro team's token lands on a Solo space on the game board, the Home team performs a charade from the *SOLO* section of this booklet.

1. Stop the video tape.
2. The player whose turn it is to act out a Solo charade announces a page number (from p. 1 to p. 10) and a charade number (from 1 to 50) at random and then opens this booklet to that charade. (Before acting out the charade, the player should first think about how he or she will perform it.)
3. As soon as the player starts to act out the charade, the timekeeper begins to monitor the time using a watch or clock with a second hand. The player acts out the Solo charade while the Home team tries to guess the complete charade in *less* time than was taken by the Pro team.

Note: The estimated time for the Pro team to answer each Solo charade is listed at the back of this booklet according to the charade's number. **DO NOT LOOK AT THE PRO TEAM'S TIME UNTIL THE HOME TEAM HAS GIVEN ITS COMPLETE ANSWER.**

4. As soon as the Home team gives its complete answer, the timekeeper notes the number of seconds and then refers to the back of this booklet to compare the Home team's time to that of the Pro team. The team that took the *least* amount of time wins the round and has its token moved ahead 3 spaces on the game board.

Example: If the Home team guessed the Solo charade in 35 seconds and the Pro team guessed it in 45 seconds, the Home team wins the round and moves ahead 3 spaces.

Ties

If the Home team's time and the Pro team's time are the same, it's a tie. **NO TOKENS ARE MOVED AHEAD ON THE BOARD.**

5. When a Solo charade sequence is completed, begin the next round by starting the video cassette.


END OF GAME AND WINNING

Game play continues until one team's token crosses the finish line on the game board. The team to cross the finish line first wins the game!

CHARADE SIGNS


The charade signs used in this game are illustrated here for your reference.

Standard Signs




1. NUMBER OF WORDS

With the back of the hand facing out, hold up the number of fingers equal to the number of words in the charade.




3. NUMBER OF SYLLABLES

With the palm facing down, place the number of fingers equal to the number of syllables on the middle of your straightened arm.



2. WHICH WORD


With the palm facing out, hold up the appropriate number of fingers to indicate the position of the word in relationship to the whole charade.




4. WHICH SYLLABLE

With the palm facing up, place the appropriate number of fingers on the middle of your straightened arm to indicate the specific syllable.




5. SMALL WORD



7. SHORTEN THE WORD




6. STRETCH THE WORD




8. WHOLE CONCEPT

Use this sign when you want to express the general idea of a word or whole charade.



9. OPPOSITE OF




11. KEEP GOING,


10. TYPE OR KIND OF






13. SOUNDS LIKE




15. BRING IT TOGETHER

Use this sign when you want the players to bring two or more words or ideas together to guess a charade.












