ROSE-PETAL PLACE

Where is Nastina? The Hiding-Spider Card Game

For 2 to 4 players/Ages 4 to 8

EQUIPMENT

35 playing cards (6 Iris, 6 Lily Fair, 6 Orchid, 6 Sunny Sunflower, 6 Daffodil, 2 Rose-Petal, 2 Centipede/Snailsworth, 1 Nastina) * 1 Instruction card.

OBJECT

Try to score the most points by making pairs. But remember that you can't win with NASTINA the spider, so try not to get caught with her at the end of the game!

SET UP

- 1. Shuffle the cards. Deal 4 cards face down to each player.
- 2. Stack the remaining cards **face down** in the middle of the playing area. This is the draw pile.
- 3. The youngest player goes first. Play continues to the first player's left.

PLAYING

- 1. Start your turn by taking **one** card from the player on your left. Don't peek at the player's cards first and don't show it to anyone else.
- 2. Look at your hand. Can you make a pair? If you can, lay the pair **face up** in front of you. You may make more than one pair on a turn. If you can't make a pair, end your turn.
- 3. End your turn by drawing as many cards as you need to bring your hand back to four. If you already have four or more cards, do not draw any more.
- 4. When the draw pile is depleted, continue taking cards from the player on your left until all pairs are laid down.

WINNING

Anyone who is not left holding NASTINA has escaped getting caught in her web! These players add up the total point value of their cards. To count: the pair of ROSE-PETALS is 2 points, the pair of CENTIPEDE/SNAILSWORTH is 2 points, all other flower pairs are 1 point each. Whoever has the most points wins the game.

In case of a tie, the player with the ROSE-PETAL pair wins. If there is no ROSE-PETAL pair, the player with the CENTIPEDE/SNAILSWORTH pair wins. If there's still a tie, there's more than one winner.
