


HOW TO OPERATE

- Talking Barney is a soft, friendly dinosaur who says hundreds of special phrases.
- To start the fun, squeeze Talking Barney's right hand or hug his tummy!
- When you squeeze Talking Barney's right hand, he'll suggest a fun thing to do: "Pretend to tiptoe like an horse" (or a monkey, or a duck...). Or he might say, "Please find something red" (or round, or purple...).
- When you hug or squeeze Talking Barney's tummy, he'll say some encouraging words: "Please hug me again" or "Remember, I love you."
- With each squeeze, you never know what Talking Barney will say next. But if you squeeze his hand or tummy for more than two seconds, he will repeat the previous phrase up to two times.
- If not in use, Talking Barney will automatically shut off after 90 seconds.


 (During the 90-second period, Talking Barney will say a phrase approximately every 30 seconds, then sign off with a musical sound.)

HOW TO REPLACE BATTERIES

Talking Barney comes with 3 EVEREADY® Super Heavy Duty brand batteries.







D SYNCE COMPAND OF SWINDS IN SECTION OF SECT

- 1. To install new batteries, open the closure on the back of the toy and pull out the electronic unit inside. NOTE: The electronic unit is permanently attached to the toy by the electrical cord. Do not attempt to remove cord from unit or toy.
- 2. With Phillips screwdriver, loosen screw on battery compartment door and remove door. Discard used batteries and insert 3 "AA" Eveready® batteries (alkaline recommended) as shown.
- 3. Refit door on battery compartment and retighten screw. Reinsert electronic unit into toy (as far inside as possible) and reseal closure.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- 1. When installing replacement batteries, be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always John Control (1988) follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries.
- 3. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 4. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.

HOW TO CARE FOR TALKING BARNEY (SURFACE WASHABLE ONLY)

- To keep Talking Barney clean, use a soft cloth dampened with a mild soap; rinse and dry with a soft cloth.
- Avoid exposing Talking Barney to excessive heat or submersion in water, which could cause damage.

IF THERE'S A PROBLEM...

- Change the batteries if Barney will not talk, his voice sounds scratchy or he talks intermittently without being activated.
- If Talking Barney doesn't work after batteries are replaced, check to be sure batteries are inserted
