








## TO ACTIVATE PLAY MODE


- 1. Use a Phillips® screwdriver to loosen screw and remove battery cover.




Press the on/off button to activate helicopter. Press upper button to activate siren sounds and flashing lights.


4. Attach winch hook onto gurney and lower gurney using winch wheel. Lowering and raising winch activates winch-grinding sounds and speech.




