



# How To Insert Batteries

1. Loosen screw on battery compartment door with a Phillips® screwdriver.





2. Insert flat head screwdriver into slot. Press it against tab and lift up until battery compartment door is lifted out of compartment.

3. Insert 4 "D" size batteries in the order (1-4) shown in the illustration, and in the position (+ or -) shown inside the battery compartment.




4. Replace door in compartment and snap tab into place. Tighten screw.

# **Authory Cautions**

- 1. be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Never mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.


### How To Take Yo-Yo For A Walk

1. Hold leash in one hand with control switch in the palm of your hand.



2. Press down on one side of the switch to make Yo-Yo walk forward. Press down on the other side of the switch to make her walk backward. Note: Yo-Yo will only move when you press down on the switch.

stop Yo-Yo, remove your finger from the switch.



### Where Yo-Yo Likes To Walk

• Yo-Yo walks best on flat floors and pavement. Do not walk her on grass, sand, or gravel, or through mud or water. She does not walk up or down stairs.

# Special Moves

- You can make Yo-Yo beg by pulling up on her leash and depressing the remote control switch in either direction.
- Yo-Yo can be guided in any direction you want gently pull on the leash as she walks to guide her in the direction you want her to walk.

# Washing and Grooming Yo-Yo

• Wash Yo-Yo with a damp cloth and mild soap. Let damp plush dry before grooming.

#### Cautions

- Do not submerge Yo-Yo in water.
- Always watch where you are going when you are walking with Yo-Yo.
- Do not sit or ride on Yo-Yo.
- Do not push Yo-Yo along floor. Always use remote control switch to move Yo-Yo.
