You Just Became a MILLIONAIRE



For 3 to 6 Players | Ages 10 to Adult

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Directions

(Please read all directions aloud before playing.)

It came out of the blue . . . the lottery, an inheritance, or a "big win" at a casino . . . and now you have more money than you ever imagined.

Having incredible wealth presents opportunities, as well as challenges — the possibilities are unlimited! But what will you do with all that money — buy a huge house; support a charity; acquire dazzling jewelry and luxury cars; take trips to exotic locations; fund your own political campaign; change your style of clothing; or invest prudently?

Do you think you know how your friends and family would spend their money? Do they know what you would do? Would all that money change them, or change you?

Well, now you and your friends and family can find out . . . by playing YOU JUST BECAME A MILLIONAIRE $^{\text{M}}$.

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Object

The object of the game is to win the most money by correctly guessing how the other players will answer questions about their newfound wealth.

Playing this game is really about dreams of being rich and having fun—so enjoy the fantasy! Some cards describe specific situations that may not apply to every player. For example, even though the players may not work for another person (they may be self-employed, or in school or retired) the questions that involve working for another person should be answered, "as if the player does."

Contents

- One set of 114 YOU JUST BECAME A MILLIONAIRE™ cards (the questions)
- A lot of money in \$1,000,000; \$2,000,000; and \$3,000,000 bills
- 6 sets of YOU CAN BET ON IT cards (4 cards per set)

To Start

1. Take 30 of the YOU JUST BECAME A MILLIONAIRE cards from the deck and set them aside, face down. These are the cards to use for this play of the game. DO NOT READ THE CARDS BEFORE PLAYING!

The set of 30 cards will take about one hour to play. To distribute the turns evenly, distribute 32 cards if four people are playing. Of course, you may adjust the length of the Game by using more or fewer question cards.

- 2. Distribute one set of 4 YOU CAN BET ON IT CARDS to each player. Each player receives cards marked "A," "B," "C," and "D."
- 3. Select one player to be the "banker." The banker gives each player a total of \$20,000,000. THAT'S RIGHT, \$20 MILLION (three \$1,000,000; four \$2,000,000, and three \$3,000,000 bills). All of the players are now filthy rich!

The players, now mature and wealthy, agree on who goes first. In the event that no agreement can be reached, the player with the most "real" money (cash only) in his/her pocket or purse goes first. Play then proceeds clockwise with each player taking a turn being "The Millionaire."

To Play

1. The first player draws a question card from the cards being used for this game and reads it aloud. The player reading the question is referred to as "The Millionaire."

The Millionaire then selects the YOU CAN BET ON IT card that represents his/her answer and places the card face down.

Now that all the players are rich they can afford to be honest. To fully enjoy YOU JUST BECAME A MILLIONAIRE, each question should be answered honestly. When you answer the questions, remember to keep this in mind: you are very, very wealthy!

- 2. The players then guess how The Millionaire answered by selecting either "A," "B," "C," or "D" from their set of YOU CAN BET ON IT cards. The selected card should be placed face down. Some questions offer only two or three answer choices.
- 3. Each player must bet \$1-, \$2-, or \$3 million dollars that his/her YOU CAN BET ON IT card selection will match The Millionaire's answer, and place the bet next to the selected card.

- **4.** After all bets have been placed, The Millionaire then reveals his/her answer by showing the YOU CAN BET ON IT card that he/she selected. The players then turn over their YOU CAN BET ON IT cards.
- 5. Players who correctly guessed The Millionaire's answer win the bet: they take back the money they bet, and collect an equal amount from the Bank. Players who guessed incorrectly must pay the Bank the amount they bet.
- 6. The player to the left of the first player now takes a turn as The Millionaire. Players continue to take turns being The Millionaire until all the question cards being used in the Game have been read.

Winning the Game

The player with the most money at the end of the Game wins. However, if at any time during the Game a player loses all of his/her money, he/she is eliminated from the Game.
