

YOUNG AMERICAN TARGET RULES

For any number of players

Attractive, entertaining, harmless! This Target recommends itself, on account of its absolute safety. The Balls, being made of a special hard wax, there is no danger of injury to the furniture or the room.

Hang the Target on the wall so that it will be about on the level with the heads of the players.

The first Player takes the Five Balls, and standing about eight feet from the Target, throws them, in succession, in the effort to strike the Bull's-eye.

COUNT

After the five Balls are thrown, any ball remaining in the Bull's eye counts 50 for that player. Any Ball remaining in the middle circle counts 25. Any Ball remaining in the outer circle counts 10. Any Ball which, after sticking to the Target is knocked off or falls off before the player completes his throw of five, does not count. Any Ball resting on the line between the numbered circles on the Target counts as if in the lower numbered circle.

For example: A Ball resting on the line between the Bull's eye and the middle circle counts 25. One resting on the outside line of the outer circle counts nothing.

Players play in turn, each throwing the five Balls at a turn. The player who first makes the score of 1000 WINS THE GAME.

Note: For very little folks the score may be reduced to 500 and for larger children it may be increased to 2,000 if so desired.
