

TROUBLESHOOTING

Are you having trouble with your scanner? Try these tips!

If your scanner...

Try this!

Sounds garbled...

Install three new LR44/AG13 button cell batteries

Doesn't make sound...

Install three new LR44/AG13 button cell batteries

CHANGING THE BATTERIES

Your scanner needs three LR44/AG13 button cell batteries. Follow these steps to install the batteries. Batteries must be installed and removed by an adult.

1. Unscrew the battery cover.
2. Insert the batteries as indicated.
3. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw.

BATTERY SAFETY:

- Do not put the batteries in backwards. Positive (+) and negative (-) ends must be inserted in the correct directions following the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries must be removed before recharging.
- Rechargeable batteries must be recharged by an adult only.
- Batteries must be installed and removed by an adult only.
- Remove exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Do not try to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Work together to fill your shopping basket with the food on your grocery list.

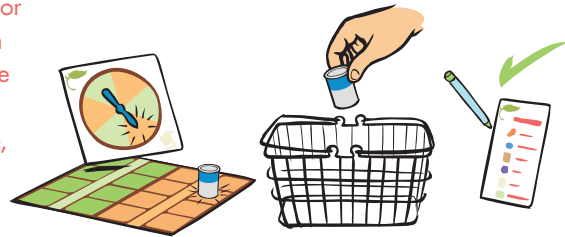
GET READY

1. Set out the game board, erasable pen, scanner, spinner, play food, basket, and grocery lists.
2. Fill the game board with the food, putting one item in each spot.
3. Choose one grocery list. All players work together to complete the list.



HOW TO PLAY

Take turns spinning the spinner. What color did you spin? Is anything from your list in this aisle? If so, scan the food, put it in the basket, and check it off your list with the pen. If none of your items are in the aisle, it's the next player's turn.



HOW TO WIN

When all the items on your grocery list are checked off, you win!

KEEP PLAYING!

Extend the fun of Shop & Match and help all of your child's natural abilities blossom with these do-together activities.



DISCOVER

- Practice counting using the Shop & Match foods. Pick a number and ask your child to put this many things in the shopping basket. Then empty the basket and choose a different number.
- Help your child put the foods in different categories. For example, sort the items into fruits, vegetables, dairy, grains, drinks, or snacks.

PERFORM

- Hide the foods around a room, making sure to place them high, low, and at eye level. Watch as your child stretches, squats, and maneuvers to pick up the food and collect it in the shopping basket.
- Have your child pick a food and try balancing it in the palm of their hand while walking across the room. Try balancing a different food in each hand, balancing one on your head, or even crabwalking and balancing a food on your belly. Do it together and be silly!



CREATE

- Do a color hunt in your kitchen or at the real grocery store. Pick a color, then hunt for foods of this color.
- Use the blank card and the pen to make a Shop & Match color shopping list. Write down six colors, then take turns spinning and looking for items that are these colors.

CONNECT

- Choose three play food pieces and take turns ranking them from least favorite to most favorite. Then pick out three different foods and do it again.
- Use the blank card and the pen to make a Shop & Match letter shopping list. Write down the first letter for six of the food items. Take turns spinning and looking for items that start with these letters.
