

KEEP PLAYING!

Extend the fun of Stamp and Mail and help all of your child's natural abilities blossom with these fun, do-together activities.



DISCOVER

- Hunt for silly things to put in the mailbag. Can you find something smaller than a stamp? Bigger than your shoe? Something fuzzy? Take turns searching and making deliveries.
- Play a memory game with your sticker stamps, letters, and postcards. Place them face down. Turn over one stamp and one letter. Did you get a match?

PERFORM

- Turn a room into a post office. Set out the mailbox and invite everyone to visit and exchange letters and postcards.
- Use the mailbox to exchange surprises with your child. Take turns leaving little somethings for each other: a cookie, small toy, or note.

CREATE

- Spread out the postcards and letters and practice matching colors. Take turns picking the color and hunting for all the pictures that include this color.
- Have your child make a special post office sign for their room. Hang the sign on the door when the "post office" is open.

CONNECT

- Take turns asking and answering questions like "What do you think a squirrel would write in a letter?" or "What do you think our dog or cat would write in a letter to us?"
- Talk with your child about writing and receiving letters. Who would you like to write to, and who would you like to receive a letter from? Tell your child about a special letter you got when you were growing up.

- If the flag detaches from the mailbox, simply pop it back into place.
