
Sometimes babies are fussy because they are hungry. You can say, "Is baby hungry?" and pretend to feed her with the bottle.




After her bottle, pretend to burp her. Put your baby doll on your shoulder and gently tap her back.




Pretend she is crying. Oh no! What's the matter, baby?

Next, open and close her arms to pretend she is clapping her hands. You can help her clap and sing a song to her!








Sing:

Meal time can be messy! Pretend to wipe food off your baby dolls' faces with a towel. You can say, "That's better. All clean!"



Now that they are all cleaned up, it's time for a nap! First, you and your friend can pick out a book and read them a bedtime story.



Then, pretend to get your baby dolls ready for nap time.



Take a blanket from home and put it over them.



Say, "Night night, little babies! Sleep tight!" Give them goodnight kisses and say, "I love you, baby!"
