Since you know your child best, it is up to you to pick which products and resources are most appropriate for his or her level of ability. Make sure you supervise the play as needed, and don't modify the products.



Have an adult assemble all the pieces before you get started.



The Chutes and Ladders® game comes with all of these things.

This is the spinner.



This is the game board.



These are the pieces. Let's count them!




Which piece do you want to use? You can say: "I like ____."

There are some ladders on the game board. Ladders go up.* Let's point to all 9 ladders on the game board and count them!

There are also some chutes on the game board. Chutes go down.* Now let's point to all 9 chutes on the game board and count them!



^{*}See playbook levels 2 and 3 to incorporate chutes into the game.

This is how you'll move on the board from beginning to end.




Now you're ready to play! First, put your piece next to square #1.



Next, you spin the spinner.



The spinner landed on 3, so move your piece 3 squares.





Keep spinning the spinner and moving your piece the same number of squares.



When you get to square #100, you win! Playing the CHUTES AND LADDERS game is fun!

Have an adult help assemble all the pieces before you get started.



The Chutes and Ladders® game is fun to play! Here is what the game comes with.

First, you will need to pick a piece to play with. You can say, "I choose _____."



Next, put your piece next to square #1 to start.



As you play the game, this is the way you will move from beginning to end on the board. Each square has a number to help you keep track.



On your turn, spin the spinner and move that many spaces on the board.

FIRST



Spin the spinner.

THEN



Move your piece.





When you land on a square with a ladder, move to the top. Whee!

When you land on a square with a chute, slide down to the bottom.
Whoo!

Keep spinning the spinner and moving along the squares. When you reach the 100th square, the game is all done.
