## Waiting Room Busy Bags

### What You Need

- Crayons
- Markers
- Colored pencils
- Paper
- Coloring books
- Stickers
- Resealable zipper plastic bags



### How You Do It

- 1** Decide what items you want to put in your "busy kits". (Think about the age of the children to whom you want to donate and be sure the items are geared to that age group.)
- 2** There are some online "dollar stores" where you can purchase items in bulk at bargain prices.
- 3** Purchase items and assemble "busy kits" in bags.
