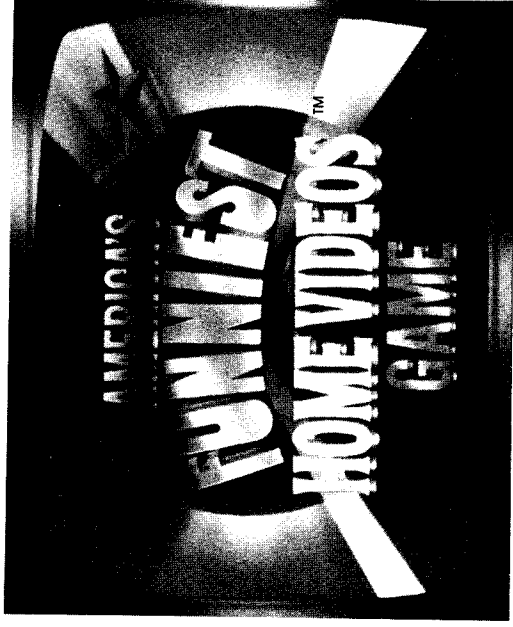

Rules for Gameplay

HOW TO PLAY

For 3-6 players or teams / Ages 8 and up

OBJECT

To be the first player to reach the \$100,000 goal at the end of the track.

EQUIPMENT

90-minute videotape • Rules/Q&A booklet for Clips #1 - 117 • Q&A booklet for Clips #118 - 257 • Deck of 35 cards • Answer Pad • Scratch pad
• Game board • 6 Pawns

SETUP

1. Give each player a sheet from the Answer Pad (for playing Video Vote and Video Caption) and a sheet from the blank Scratch Pad (for writing Video Captions).
2. Each player selects a pawn and puts it at the AMERICA'S FUNNIEST HOME VIDEOS TV screen Start space on the game board.
3. Keep this Rules/Q&A booklet where everyone can reach it during game-play.
4. Shuffle the deck of 35 cards.
5. Pick a player to go first.
6. Pop the Videotape into the VCR, and prepare to laugh!

Note: You may need to adjust the tracking on your VCR for a clearer picture.

GAMEPLAY

On your turn you:

- Draw one card from the shuffled deck to determine which of the three possible gameplay variations the group will play this round — VIDEO VOTE, CRAZY CAPTION, or VIDEO Q&A. The YOUR CHOICE card lets you select which of the three the group will play.
- Now that you know which variation you're playing, start the videotape. In all variations, everybody watches the same video(s).
- At the end of the video(s), vote, write a caption, or answer a question, according to the card descriptions below, then score by moving your pawn along the track on the game board.
- Play passes to the player on the left, who repeats the above steps.

The Cards: If it's your turn, draw a card. Here's what you do if you draw:

VIDEO VOTE

Everyone, use your Answer Sheet to vote. Watch 3 videos and rank them.

1. Watch three videos in a row; **pause** the tape.
2. You rank the three clips in order of how funny you think they are.
3. Everybody else tries to match you, so they all write down how they think you voted.

Example: If you think the third clip was the funniest, rank it with a 1. If the first clip was second funniest, give it a 2. The one you found least funny gets a 3.
Note: You want as many players as possible to match you.

3. **Scoring:** Any player who matches your voting exactly (by getting all three in exact order) moves ahead one space. **You move ahead one space for each player who has matched you!**

CRAZY CAPTION

Everyone, use a sheet from the Scratch Pad to write your caption, and use your Answer Sheet to vote. Watch 1 video, write captions, and guess who wrote what.

1. Select and read one of the incomplete phrases on the back of the card, then...
2. Watch one video; **stop** the tape.
3. Everyone writes his or her own caption by filling in the blank to complete the phrase.
4. Collect all the captions, shuffle them up so no one can tell whose is whose, and read each one aloud.
5. All players use their Answer Sheet to jot down who they think wrote which caption.

7. **Scoring:** Everyone else who correctly matches the writer with the caption he or she wrote moves up one space for each match. Because you had the advantage of seeing everyone's handwriting, you get a bonus: if you stumped everybody with your caption, and not a single player guessed you wrote it, move ahead a space for each player you fooled; if you stumped five other players, you move five spaces!

VIDEO Q&A

Watch 1 video and answer a question about it.

1. Watch one clip; note the clip's number and **pause** the tape.
2. Pick a number — 1, 2 or 3. The player to your right turns to that number clip in the Q&A section of the appropriate booklet, and reads you the first, second or third question, depending on which number you picked.
3. **Scoring:** If you answer it correctly, move ahead one space. But if you get it wrong, the person to your left gets a crack at it — and moves two spaces for getting it right! The third player who tries would move three spaces for the right answer, the fourth, four spaces, etc., until someone gets it right, or it comes back around to you; you don't get a second chance at it!

Note: "House Rules" must be in force here. Our "answers" in the booklets are the most obvious ones. If a player gives a different answer that is actually correct in point of fact but is not what we've given, it's up to all players to decide if they'll accept it or not. You'll see what we mean as you play!

WINNING THE GAME

The first player to reach the \$100,000 goal at the end of the game board track wins the game.
