Remove the frame holding the Baskets from the box and then remove the two wooden endsupports, placing frame firmly into the slotted part of these supports and screwing the turn screws up into the frame until the frame and supports are firmly fastened together. Three colored disks come with the game.

Place the supported frame-work upon a table or upon the floor. Each player in turn throws these three disks at the Baskets which are in an upright position, standing at such distance from the Baskets as may be determined upon beforehand by the players. (A distance of from six to eight feet is recommended.)

Each Basket is numbered on its wooden extension at the top and if a disk falls into the Basket, the Basket will drop showing this score.

The game is for 500 points and the player first attaining this score, or better, WINS THE GAME.
