## GETTING STARTED

M ake sure your game.com system is 0 FF . Insert the TIG ER CA SIN 0 cartridge into cartridge slot 1. Turn on game.com. Touch CARTRIDGE on the $M$ ain $M$ enu Screen. A fter a brief animation, you'll find yourself at the TIG ER CASIN 0 M ain Screen. Here you'll have three choices: TIG ER CASIN 0 , $O$ PTIO N S and EXIT
$O n$ the $M$ ain Screen, touch Tiger $C$ asino (or use the directional pad to position the cursor next to TIG ER CASIN 0 and then press the "A" button). This will begin the game.

Next you will be taken to the "W hat's Your Game?" Screen. Here you will be able to select which casino game you want to try. To choose a game,

W hen you are ready to leave the casino, you have two options. You may touch ceshoum to go to your personalized statistic screen. Or you may touch ERIII to return to the Tiger $C$ asino $M$ ain Screen.

Your Statistic Screen
Here you will see your total score plus how well you have done at each game. The record of your time in the casino is also kept here. If you want, you may touch cosiso to return the "W hat's Your G ame?" screen and continue playing. 0 r , you may touch ERIIT and be taken to the Password Screen.


The Password Screen
If you touch ERIT from the Statistic Screen, you will be taken to the Password Screen. Here you will receive a four character password that will retain all the information you just saw on the Statistic Screen. Write this password down. You may enter it and return to the casino again from where you last left off. This is especially handy for games lasting many days and multiple sittings. A fter all, you don't want to ruin a lucky streak just because you have to sleep, now do you?


Touch here to go to the Tiger Casino $M$ ain Screen.

## O PTIO N S

There are several different options that you may wish to change before playing the game. You will find these variables listed on the 0 ptions Screen. Touch "Options" from the Tiger $C$ asino $M$ ain Screen to go to the 0 ptions Screen.

Touch here go to the Password (Input) Screen.

Starting M oney
By default, you will begin the game automatically with 500 . If you wish to move this starting number either higher or lower, simply touch the amount to cycle through the choices. Stop touching when you are happy with your selection.

You may begin with $1,50,100,250,500,1000,2500$ or 5000 .
Credit Limit
If you are prone to periods of bad luck, you may want to establish a C redit Line with the Casino Bank. Before you begin playing, go to the options screen and decide how much in debt you would be willing to go. The default credit limit is " 0 ." This means that if you lose all of your money, the game will be over. You may touch the " 0 " on the 0 ptions screen (next to "Credit Limit") to cycle through the different credit plans the bank has to offer. You may set the Limit to $1,50,100,250,500,1000,2500,5000,7500$ or 10000 . The amount you set here will indicate the amount of money the bank will lend you if you lose your Starting M oney. If you have to use this C redit, your score will appear as a negative number (since you will be using the Bank's money and therefore be in debt). If you are an unlucky person you might want a high C redit Limit.

Password Input
If you press the $N \mathrm{O}$ that is located next to the "password" option (changing it to YES), PASS: will appear. Touc PASS: to advance to the Password (Input) Screen.

Passwords are automatically given when you C ash O ut of a game. If you have received a password from a previous game, you may input it here and continue from where you left off. Touch the symbols that correspond to the password you received. You may touch 慜 if you make a mistake. When you have input the password, press Esize to start the game. If the password is incorrect the game will not begin. You may press ERHIT to return to the 0 ptions Screen.

## TIGER VIDEO PO KER

A fter you have touched the PO KER icon on the＂W hat＇s Your Game？＂screen，you will begin the Tiger Video Poker game．First you will see a brief animation．A fter this ends，you will see the Tiger Video Poker Table．This is where the game will be played．

Playing Tiger Video Poker W hen you are ready，touch
（651） 0 bet．When you are satisfied with your wager，touch［⿴囗玉A］．Next the computer will deal 5 cards．Under each card will appear Tint Touch minit for each card you wish to keep．When you have selected all the cards you want to keep， touch［国］to have the computer deal replacement cards for the ones that were not held．If you have a winning combination，those cards will begin to flash and your score will be credited with the correct amount．
When you are ready to play a different game，touch to go to the＂W hat＇s Your Game？＂screen．

SPECIAL HAND DESC RIPTIO N
Royal Flush = The five highest cards (10, Jack, Q ueen, King, A ce) in any one suit (Hearts, Diamonds, Spades, Clubs).
Example: 10 of H earts, J ack of H earts, Q ueen of H earts, King of Hearts , A ce of Hearts.
Straight Flush = Five cards of the same suit in consecutive order.
Example: 2 of Diamonds, 3 of Diamonds, 4 of Diamonds, 5 of Diamonds, 6 of Diamonds.

Full House $=2$ cards of one value and 3 of another.
Example: 10 of Hearts, 10 of Spades, 2 of Diamonds, 2 of Spades, 2 of $C$ lubs.
Flush $=5$ cards of one suit, but not in consecutive order.
Example: 2 of Clubs, 6 of Clubs, 10 of Clubs, King of Clubs, A ce of Clubs.
Straight $=5$ cards in consecutive order, but not of the same suit.
Example: 6 of Clubs, 7 of Spades, 8 of Diamonds, 9 of Spades, 10 of H earts.
TIG ER VIDEO BLACKJACK
A fter you have touched the BLACK JACK icon on the "W hat's Your Game?" screen, you will begin the Tiger Video BLACK JACK game. First you will see a brief animation. A fter this ends, you will see the Tiger Video BLACK JACK Table.
This is where the game will be played.

The Tiger Video BLACKJACK Table


Playing Tiger Video BLACK JACK When you are ready, touch , When you are satisfied with your wager, touch . Next the computer will deal you 2 cards. The computer will also deal itself 2 cards. The object is to be the closest to 21 without going over. You will be able to see both of your cards, but only 1 of the dealer's. Based on what you see, you must decide if you want to HIT (take another card), STAND (stay with the cards you have) or DO UBLE (double your bet, but take only one additional card). You may only DO UBLE on your first card after the initial deal.

The Computer Dealer plays by certain rules. The Dealer will HIT on a score of 16, but will stand on a score of 17 .

The cards you play with are worth their face value. The face cards () ack, Queen, King) are worth 10. An Ace may be used as either a 1 or an 11 (you decide)!

If you and the Dealer tie on a hand, it will be considered a "Push" and no one wins.

If you go over 21, you will "Bust" and will lose the hand (unless the Dealer also "Busts", in which case the hand will be a "Push").

W hen you are ready to play a different game, touch
[aw to go to the "W hat's Your $G$ ame?" screen.

If you want to check the winning payout chart for Tiger Video BLACK JACK, press [ $\overline{\mathrm{imm}}]$. You will be taken to the Payout $C$ hart. Touch $\mathrm{\Delta}_{\mathrm{\Delta}} \mathrm{em}$ to return to the BLACK JACK Game. The Payouts for Tiger Video BLACK JACK are:

## TIG ER H I-LO W

A fter you have touched the HI-LO W icon on the "W hat's Your Game?" screen, you will begin the Tiger Video HI-LO W game. First you will see a brief animation. A fter this ends, you will see the Tiger Video HI-LO W Table. This is where the game will be played.

The Tiger H I-LO W Table


If you and the Dealer tie on a hand, you'll go to "W ar"! The bet will automatically be doubled and two more cards will be dealt. The highest card will win.

W hen you are ready to play a different game, touch

If you want to check the winning payout chart for Tiger V ideo HI-LO W, press Znan . You will be taken to the Payout $C$ hart. Touch H I-LO W G ame. The Payouts for Tiger V ideo H I-LO W are:

A fter you have touched the RO ULETTE icon on the "W hat's Your Game?" screen, you will begin the Roulette game. First you will see a brief animation. A fter this ends, you will see the Roulette Table. This is where the game will be played.

This first screen will allow you to check the Info screen, Leave (go back to the What's Your $G$ ame? Screen) and Bet.

Roulette is a game in which a small ball is rolled on a wheel. This wheel has many different numbers and colors on it. If you can correctly choose the number or color that the ball will land in, you will win. Depending upon how much you bet and in what configuration, you could come away a big winner. Sounds easy, doesn't it?

O nce you have touched BET, you will be taken to the Roulette Table. Touch anywhere on the table to place your bets.


You may place chips directly on the numbers or you may choose to split your bets. If you place a chip on the line between 2 different numbers, you will win if the ball lands on either number, but the winning amount will be reduced by half. You may also place a bet on the corner between 4 different numbers. A gain, if any of the 4 numbers come up you win, but the payoff will be reduced by approximately one-fourth. There are many different ways to place bets in Roulette. The following is a list of them and their odds:

| BET | 0 DDS |
| :---: | :---: |
| STRA IG HT (EN PLA IN) | $35: 1$ |
| SPLTT (A CHEVAL) | $17: 1$ |
| CORN ER (CARE) | $8: 1$ |
| $1 \cdot 12$ (as ONE bet) | $3: 1$ |
| $13-24$ (as ON bet) | $3: 1$ |
| $25-36$ (as ONE bet) | $3: 1$ |
| EVEN | $2: 1$ |
| ODD | $2: 1$ |
| BLACK | $2: 1$ |
| RED | $2: 1$ |

Note that " 0 " and " 00 " are considered "green" and will not win on a RED, BLACK, EVEN or 0 DD bet.


W hen you have finished placing your bets, touch The ball will be released and the Roulette wheel will begin to turn. Eventually, the ball will come to rest on one number. If you have a bet that includes that number, you win! Experiment with all the different ways you can bet.

## TIG ER SLOT MACHINES

There isn't too much strategy in Slots. Just put your money in and pull the machine's arm. The tumblers will turn and spin. W hen they stop, you could be the big winner. A re you determined enough to play until you hit the jackpot?

A fter touching Slots from the "W hat's your game?" screen, you will be taken to the "C hoose Your M achine" Screen. Touch either the T-Rex Slots or the Slots 0 ' Fruit machine to begin playing.

T-Rex Slots
You're the big game hunter on the track of that most elusive quarry: the T-Rex. There have been scattered sighting of this most fearsome and dangerous adversary, but not definitive proof. It's up to you to capture the terrible lizard. Every time you do, you will be greatly rewarded. But beware; with great reward comes great risk.

Slots 0 ' Fruit
This slot machine will allow you to not only place your bet on the middle line, but on up to 4 other lines as well. With each coin you add, another line will appear. You may play up to 5 lines in total. If there is a winning combination on any of the 5 lines (and you played all five lines) you will win. You may play the middle, top and bottom lines plus the 2 diagonal ones as well.
