




### **OBJECT**

### GAME SUMMARY

Bet the Max ... and "Own it all"!" Based on slot machines in famous casinos, this hand-held holds the basic Monopoly® slots game, plus Advance to Boardwalk® and Chance bonus games, with bigger payouts! Just press a button to bet from 1 to 4 coins ... then press GO to spin the reels! Win the most "virtual" money, and you'll "Own It All!"



### PLAYING THE GAME

If no buttons are pressed for about one minute, the game will go into "sleep" mode. To "wake up" the game, press ON.

### **Starting a New Game:**

- 1. Press ON. You're given 50 "credits" to start with; each credit is worth 25¢. If a game is already in progress, the current amount will be displayed.
- If you want to reset a game in progress back to 50 credits, press and hold NEW GAME for 2 seconds.

#### How to bet:

Place your bet by pressing a red Bet button; the value of each button is 25¢. Press the "1" to bet 25¢, the "2" to bet 50¢ or the "3" to bet 75¢; press MAX BET to bet four quarters, or \$1.00.

Note: To move from the Regular Slots game into the "Advance to Boardwalk" bonus game, you must BET the MAX!

#### How to spin:

When you've placed your bet, press the green GO button to activate the virtual reels. How much you win depends on how much you bet. Check the pay line (the center line across the 3 reels) and the table below; it's also printed on the back of the game unit.

**High Score:** The unit keeps track of the high score until the Reset button is pushed or the batteries are removed. Push the High Score button to see it at any time. **Hold** the High Score button to see the credits converted to the equivalent cash amount.

### **BONUS GAMES**


Play the regular slots game well and you'll escape into one of the two bonus games, for more fun — and bigger payouts!

Advance to Boardwalk:
You'll automatically move into this bonus game if you push MAX and 1

pennybag image appears on each of the 3 reels; these do not have to appear in a row along the pay line.

It's a race! In this bonus game, press the ROLL button to move around the Monopoly gameboard. You'll collect money for landing on the various properties and passing the "GO" corner square. Move around the board as many times as you can to collect the most cash. You can make more than one circuit around the board if you're quick.

But as soon as you land on "Jail" (as shown), "Go to Jail," "Luxury Tax," or "Income Tax," or draw a "Go to Jail" card at Chance or Community Chest, you'll return to the regular slots game.

If the "Chance" symbol appears in the center reel on the pay line during regular slots (as shown), you'll jump immediately to the Chance bonus game. Press GO and the Chance display will randomly spin and either deliver a payout of a specific monetary value, or show you a multiplier that multiplies the amount of your original slots bet by that value. After the payout is complete, the game returns to regular slots play.

### **MAINTENANCE**

- Handle the game carefully.
- Store the game away from dusty or dirty areas.
- Keep the game away from moisture or temperature extremes.
- Do not disassemble the game. If a problem occurs, push in the RESET button; remove and replace the batteries to reset the computer; or try new batteries.

### **BATTERIES**

• To replace batteries: Loosen the screw on the battery compartment on the back of the unit and remove the door. Insert 2 AA size batteries (we recommend alkaline), making sure to align the + and - with the markings in the plastic. Replace the door and tighten the screw.

# **CAUTION:**

To Avoid Battery Leakage

- Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the game and battery manufacturers' instructions.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickelcadmium) batteries.
