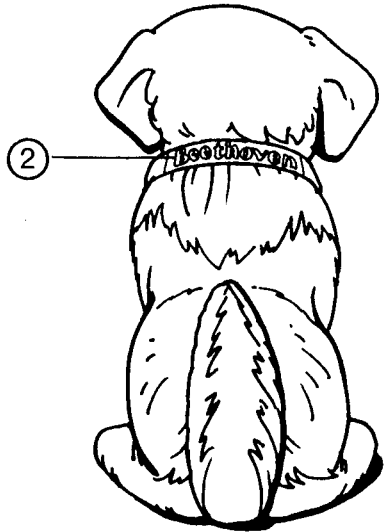
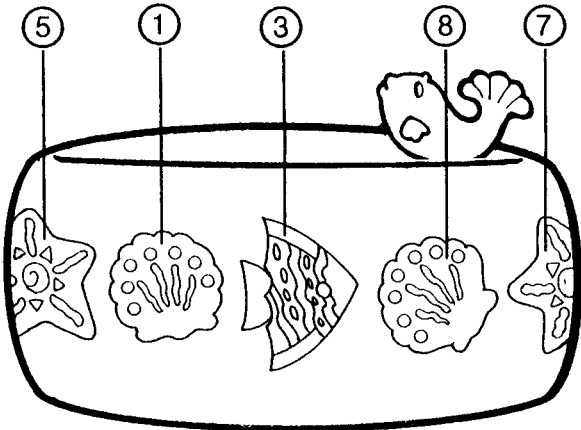
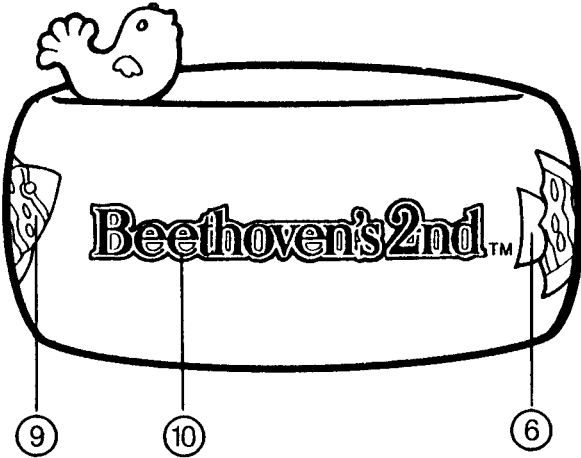
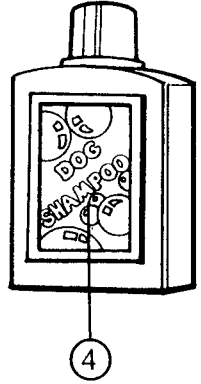




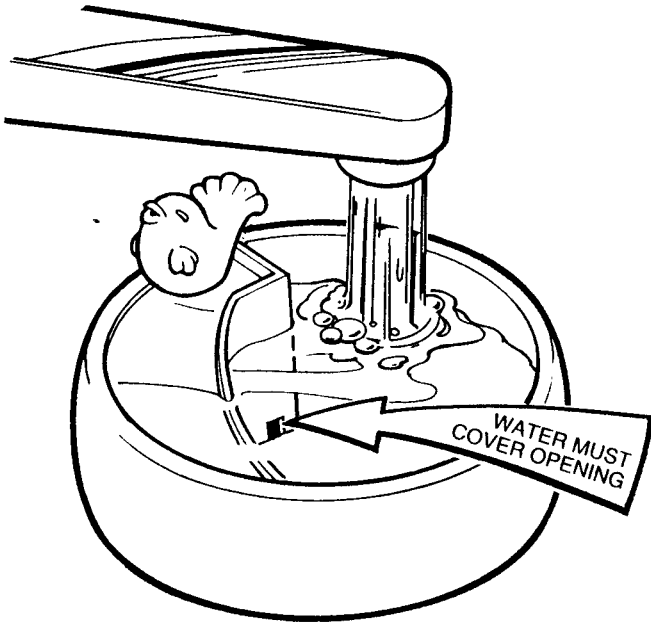
# PUPPY POOL

## LABEL APPLICATION

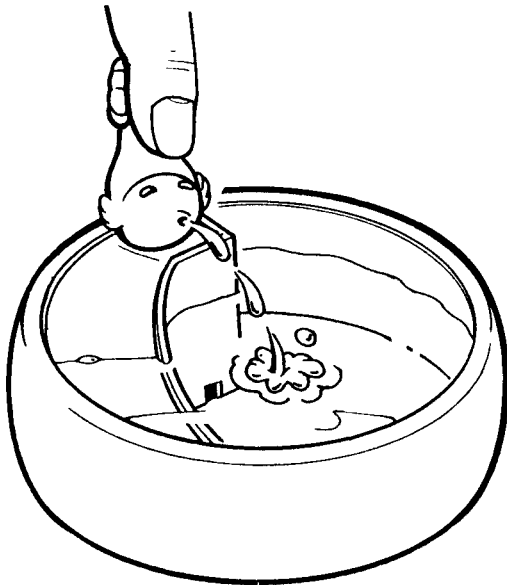
1. Apply labels to unassembled pieces using numbers on label sheet and these illustrations as a guide.



# OPERATION

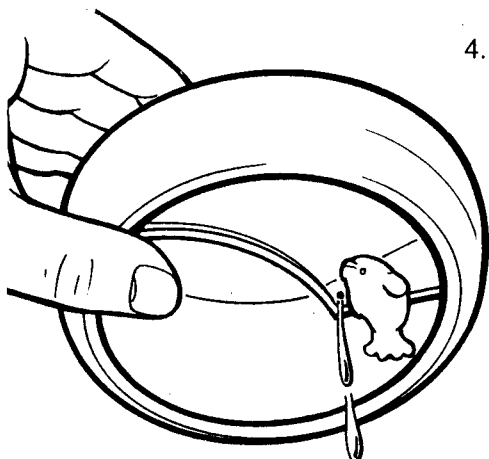


2. Fill Puppy Pool™ with tap water, at least to cover opening on the inside of pool.

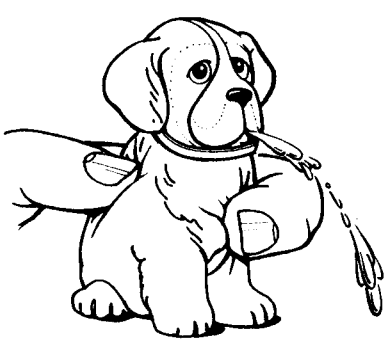


3. Pump fish up and down until it squirts water out of its mouth.

4. Pour out water to empty <sup>4</sup>/<sub>5</sub> Puppy Pool™, then pump fish until all the water is emptied out of the pool.



5. To fill Beethoven™ dog, squeeze him, then hold his head under water and release. Repeat this process until he is filled with water.



6. Slowly squeeze Beethoven™ dog so he pretends to drool, or squeeze him firmly to squirt water.

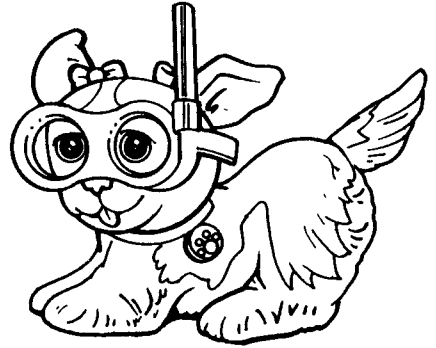


7. Float fits around Mo Pup™ puppy as shown.



8. Press down on Tchaikovsky™ puppy's tail to move front legs, pretending to splash water.

9. Place goggles on Dolly Pup™ puppy as shown.



10. Then slide Dolly Pup™ puppy down the slide in pool.



11. Move Chubby Pup™ puppy's head side to side, pretending to shake water off ears.
